

Spirituality and Capital Punishment: Contrasts and Compatibilities

A spirited email discussion on the right to live and the right to execute

The original post came from SAIGE WAITTS, asking intriguing questions based on a recent high-profile execution.

Dear fellow travelers,

In the last two days I have seen three TV shows about the Texas woman who is scheduled to be executed on Feb. 3 by lethal injection. So far I have missed the part of the show that tells what she actually did but I know it is something about murdering a woman with an ice pick. I know nothing more than that. She has had a religious conversion and is doing outreach while in prison. Unless you have seen this woman's face you may not know what I am talking about but to me she is *very* believable. There is a peace, sincerity and honesty in her face, a softness that simply aches to be saved. I don't know how someone could kill such eyes, but no doubt the husband and son of her victim felt the same way about their wife and mother.

I am curious as to what you all think about this particular case. This is not a simple situation and there are politics involved, but to me, it is far beyond a rigid interpretation of the law. I have really been struck by this and would appreciate your thoughts.

I can only say that the law of the land must be maintained regardless of the spiritual truth of the matter. I am fairly sure, as you are, she has made a life change in the direction of God. However, I see this as, on the societal level, secondary to the fact that she has been convicted of a terrrible mortal crime, of which she, as long as society deals with these offenses in this manner, should face the consequences to the full extent of the law. Social order must be kept consistant.

Further, think about all the "conversions" that will take place on death row in the wake of pardoning her because of her present Godward direction ...

While I would like to see Sage's idealism brought to bear in society's approach to such cases, we cannot, individually or as a society, see clearly into people's hearts. Norm makes an excellent point about the inequity faced by less mediagenic death row residents. And suppose that ugly, black male had a religious conversion to Islam rather than Christianity. Sage, you might still find it in your heart to go to bat for him, but I doubt if Pat Robertson would, as he has in the case of the Texas woman. William F. Buckley, a Catholic, has written in support of this born-again prisoner; would he be as quick to the defense of a Muslim convert with a longer rap sheet? Which of them would stand up for a death row inmate suddenly converted to the Urantia Book?

Given heterodoxy and the separation of church and state, our society is not today well-suited to considering such appeals to mercy. That is not to say that it is not theoretically possible. A more spiritually and morally advanced society might structure its laws, its correctional institutions and its judicial procedures so that the condemned could take a vow (to be renewed every 90 days) to dedicate her/his life to spiritual service to her/his fellows, and thereby stay the executioner. It isn't the conversion so much as the service. Something morally superior to chain gangs or prisoner-staffed telemarketing...

Although the state could undertake to craft such experiments, I am convinced that they would be doomed to failure in a society that has not acknowledged the self-evident unity of God in its founding. Self-evident unity is a moral/philosophical issue, not requiring a belief in a personal God; even so, perhaps there should be courses specifically tailored to augment the education of atheists...

Execution is probably more merciful than life imprisonment without parole.

Execution is the human attempt at justice on earth which reflects the spiritual reality of personality extinguishment. As such, it will inevitably be faulty, imperfect, flawed. The temporary removal of state execution as "cruel and unusual" by the U.S. Supreme Court did result in some slight improvement in the method of execution performed by some states, but did little to nothing to improve the accuracy of justice.

In theory, it's as just an act by society as any other form or policing, trial, and incarceration. In practice, it has been mostly prejudiced, inconsistent, and generally abominable. But that could be said of much of our human processes of justice, historically and currently. We don't throw out the baby of attempting justice because of the bathwater of our current evolutionary imperfections.

Consider (as you perhaps already have, Sage) Paper 133, Section 4, paragraph 12, page 1475. The Creator Son of our Local Universe, in his human incarnation, said to the

condemned criminal, "From talking to you, I well know you did not plan to do the thing which is about to cost you your temporal life. But you did do this evil, and your fellows have adjudged you guilty; they have determined that you shall die. You and I may not deny the state this right of self-defense in the manner of its own choosing."

Many a criminal immediately regrets the action. The one night I spent in a jail cell (bogus charges, but never mind that), there was a fellow in the next cell, wild-eyed and intense, who kept saying, "I didn't mean to kill her." He surely regretted his action, if only for his own skin's sake, but probably as well for knowing he "did do this evil." How is a human judge to know whether one is a truly repentant soul or just a good actor fishing for mercy? Some mercy may be extended if contrition seems sincere, but the justice cannot be entirely abrogated on that basis.

In any case, most human motivations for what is called "capital punishment" are barbaric. From vengeance to deterence, excuses for execution are misguided. But I hold that those who are utterly opposed to state execution per se are also misguided, tantamount to the false sentiment of partially perfected civilization of which the revelation speaks in other contexts. Its only real justification is the permanent removal of an apparent incurable threat to society, the irredeemable sociopath.

One armchair philosopher's 2ϕ worth. The moral test of such a position is whether one would be willing to suffer state execution if falsely charged. I wouldn't like it, of course, and would fight false charges to the last, but as with any understanding of the problems of mortal justice, I support the principle even when in practice it gravely errs.

This is indeed a tough case, Sage. I would say that society is justified in removing vicious killers from its midst. Society must judge based upon actions, rather than intentions and motives. Perhaps this woman DID indeed get a spiritual shock fromher actions, and has responded to it. But, rest assured, if she gets out of her legally determined punishment because she has had a religious conversion, the incidence of religious conversion will approach a hundred percent on death row. If she has indeed seen the light, she will not be harmed by her physical death.

REHABILITATION, NOT PUNISHMENT

These thoughtful comments got me going on this topic. I usually try to avoid discussions on our social institutions

because I find the culture of our civilization as reflected in our institutions to be completely counterproductive to human welfare and God's purposes as I understand them. I have accepted the evolutionary function of these institutions and acknowledge the teachings that relegate slavery and warfare and even profit-motivated economics to important phases of the evolution of civilization.

True, many exconvicts do repent and change their lives but this is not because of their treatment in jails. It is because of their reborn spirits and desire for atonement. Perhaps some few individuals try to avoid getting arrested a second time by changing their ways but this deterring result of incarceration is miniscule.

My opinion (for what it is worth) is to isolate criminals from the society at large in secure self-sufficient communities where they can receive the help they need or isolation that they require. where they will have an opportunity to demostrate repentence or simply get the time that they need for the growth of their souls. For those who continue in their antisocial behavior, at least the rest of us are protected from them.

The false sentiments and romantic ideas that have prevented our civilization from the sterilization of degenerates are also active in this area of crime prevention and the "penal" system.

Every institution of our civilization should be measured by the nurture it affords human life and by the love that it reflects.

Think of schools, hospitals, government bodies, justice systems and THE ECONOMIC SYSTEM, defense and police in the criteria of nurture of human life and the loving service of our fellows. Then determine what to do with repentent killers on death row. Then will a relevant answer be found for each case.

But, we are where we are in our civilization and we must get to where we know that we truly must be. How to do it? that will be up to each one of us to begin living our lives in the values that we regard as the highest truth that we know. Love cannot be legislated but must be found by each of us individually and we help each other along by living the love and faith that we have.

The human group that joins hands in mortal unity with the divine presence has power that grows in algebraic proportion. The hundredth monkey kicks in very quickly when mortals join hands together with the spirit of God. I sincerely believe that the love of God will catch fire on earth and overspread the planet. Till then, folks lets keep working and praying and loving for all we've got.

I think my discomfort with the idea of legalized murder is that our planet is not ready for the next level of truth about how to deal with our degenerate and

I believe this woman must pay for her actions. But if we kill her, she has gone to a gentler place and we are left here in the flesh to live with our decision that we kill people too. I believe in her conversion and I believe in her experience on the mansion worlds because of her conversion. The real lesson is with what is left behind.

The reflections offered on the death penalty have all been excellent. Many of you have probably seen the movie "Dead Man Walking" which is the story of a nun who befriends a death row inmate. The intent of this movie was to discourage the use of the death penalty. I came away from this movie with the opposite conclusion from which the writers and producers had intended. In this story the killer expressed no remorse until the very end. He maintained a hardened and callous attitude about his crimes up to the last minute. Had this person faced a life sentence his soul would have most likely stayed in this state of denial and delusion about his crime. It was only when he was confronted with the undeniable fact that his life was ending very soon that his soul experienced a conversion and a cry out for mercy. THE GALACTIC FEDERATION: Update on Planetary Changes

Greetings! We come now before you with various pieces of information. Through them, we shall attempt to convey to you what is currently going on around you.

We shall begin with your planet. At present, it is slowly moving into its final internal configurations before some major Earth surface changes can be made. These final alterations of its interior are necessary for the surface reconstructions to be done correctly. Second, your Sun is presently being realigned. When completed, these actions will stabilize your Sun so that it can carry out its new assignments.

The forces and energies constantly being exchanged between the Sun and her planets go largely unnoticed by your scientists. Most of these forces are inter-dimensional and are not measurable by your current scientific instruments. Your solar system is a complex inter-dimensional spacecraft. Its celestial power source is electrogravitic and photonic. The conscious nature of these arrangements will be altered considerably when the awareness of your beloved planet is immensely elevated.

Finally, there is the current nature of human consciousness. All of these elements are being woven to create a new reality for you.

Let us now take a closer look at your planet. Mother Earth is accomplishing her massive transformation from the central core out. Her first steps were to realign the central crystal core and to prepare it for its new tasks. This procedure meant that the geomagnetic field had to be pulled into the core.

You might see this phenomenon as a magnet, where the field is very intense near it and then diminishes as you slowly move away from it. This necessary operation temporarily thinned out the geomagnetic field's strength near and above the Earth's surface. It also increased the Earth's wobble and began to slow the planet more rapidly. **These events do not signal a physical pole shift.** Rather, they prove that the core is linking to its inter-dimensional vortices. To do this, the core must push in its magnetic field and use it to attain a critical flashover point.

Another sign of this procedure is the swift rotation of the Earth's geomagnetic poles. The Earth is now pulsing

rapidly, and more effectively harnessing its geomagnetic fields. As the geomagnetic fields are pulsed, it causes the striation layers in the Earth's mantle to realign. This specific procedure causes the massive up-wellings of magma that your geologists have noticed recently. It has also begun to put a great deal of pressure upon your planet's tectonic plate system.

It is this system that monitors the changes in your Earth's crust. The magnetic alignments or magnetic grid points are being gradually changed. These grid points are changing, to mirror the new grid points that were put into Mother Earth's subtle bodies a couple of years ago. Your planet has to be transformed into a multi-dimensional spaceship. When this event occurs, the entire solar system must be realigned as well. All planetary systems are holistic, and depend greatly on the energies derived from the central star (sun) to thrive. Hence, the Sun becomes the next major point of contention.

The Sun, since its near-nova in 1972, has been closely watched by both Galactic Federation scientists and by the local Councils of Elohim. Their primary concern was the prevention of a major solar core explosion. To accomplish this operation, the Sun was initially put into a very strong inter-dimensional hologram. In addition, the solar magnetic field was slightly altered. It was modified, not in its overall strength, but only in its surface positioning. Points of lesser and greater magnetic field concentration at the Sun's surface were gradually developed.

This unique procedure has caused the rather large bulges now seen at various places on the Sun's surface. It has also created the rather large solar flares and accompanying solar winds. These elements play another important part in our story. This potential point of instability (the solar surface bulges) was permitted for two reasons. First, the Sun's interior had to be readjusted. That is, the inner layers of super-hot plasmas had to be changed into a more stable configuration. This complicated process would greatly decrease the possibility of a core explosion. It also took away a lot of the incredible pressure created by the Sun's interior upon its core.

With this procedure now nearly completed, the pressure on the solar core has dropped by over 500 per cent. Second, inter-dimensional fields that are daily brought in and modified by the Sun had to be adjusted. This adjustment was accomplished by the use of the aforementioned solar flares. The resultant solar winds modify each planet's magnetic fields and regulate their inter-dimensional energy intake. This action, in turn, gives each planet the life

energies that it needs to survive. It also permits each planet and component of the solar system to cleanse its interdimensional vortices.

As you can now see, your solar system is unique because it contains so many different inter-dimensional constituents. This statement can also be applied to its sentient life forms. All sentient life forms in this solar system are divided into two parts.

Exploring Modern World Religions:

THE ARCANE SCHOOL: A PORTRAIT

The Best, the Worst and the Weeds

I thought some of you might enjoy this light-hearted essay I wrote. It's about how a garden can bring out the worst and best in us.

The first grave earthly error took place in a garden.

Now that I have a garden of my own, I can believe the precept. But as with anything that grows, things appear to have changed since Eve's impatience led her and her successors out of the celestial garden and into the terrestrial ones where many of us invest our spare time. Now I believe that gardens reveal as much about our virtues as our vices.

By vices, I mean the medieval catalogue of uppercase sins (Pride, Covetousness, Lust, Envy, Gluttony, Anger, Sloth) and a crop of lowercase modern ones (lack of imagination, megalomania, apathy, sadism, masochism, shortsightedness). A person's garden may also reveal his or her virtues. Unlike the vices, the virtues remain what they have always been, mysteriously immune to time's mutations. Faith, Hope, Charity, Justice, Prudence, Temperance and Fortitude. (Patience, diligence and thrift are really just minor offshoots of the uppercase virtues.) Most gardens tattle about a mix, although some twist around a central human characteristic.

"Sloth," I muttered three years ago, when my husband and I removed the sodden crust of leaves from our south-facing garden. Earlier that spring, while snow still camouflaged the promise of weeds, we had bought a tiny house with a large yard on a rural route in Portland, CT, convinced that the "real" in real estate was the land rather than the dwelling. Our land was eight-tenths of an acre that sloped into a wood. "It has real potential," the realtor had said.

As the snow ran to mud, reality galloped mercilessly through our gardens. Our then two-year-old daughter did the same through a balding lawn that provided her with beach pails of mud from which to make miniature pies for her dolls. I would later learn that the moldy shoots at center of the south garden were ancient phlox and the reddish fists that punched through the clay earth at the back were peonies. Little else was worth saving. A rhododendron held up brown leaves resembling the soles of shoes found discarded on roadsides. A Dusty Miller left from a distant summer flopped in a bone-dry corner, a caricature of its common name. A lone Echinacea took up the rear, protesting abuse and neglect as it grew rangier, its leaves gnawn, its single bud chewed in half by spring caterpillars before it could bloom. Something that

rambled and made midget clones of itself turned out to be a common weed. During rainstorms, the slope against the house openly demonstrated the evils of soil erosion.

"Ha," my husband said when he removed one of the seven buried Jack Daniels empties from a rock garden on the same side of the house. A schoolteacher, he takes a lighter view of the uppercase human errors and deceptions. A retired man who had once occupied the property had evidently used the gardens to conceal a drinking habit from his wife, whose spare time was not spent digging up weeds or transplanting perennials. (According to the nurseryman down the street, she was a gentle soul whose husband was "not very ambitious.")

Our grass was of the crab variety. Browning, frizzle-headed junipers clung to one sunny slope while, on another, shade-loving lilies of the valley silently scorched and screamed. An incognito variety of poison ivy overtook our pachysandra. Azaleas prematurely yellowed in the dry, limy clay of the back garden. "How could they?" I would ask myself repeatedly over the next two years, cursing the former landowners for their sloth, lack of imagination and sadism, as my husband and I yanked up the dead, the hopeless and the poisonous, replacing clay with loam, reseeding the lawns, bordering the gardens with brick. We brought companionable plants together, sometimes by the book, more often by trial and error.

My husband made slate and brick paths. I gave my spring and summer weekends over to sweet william, campanulas, coreopsis, roses, hollyhocks, phlox, hibiscus, irises, lilies, spiraea, thyme, hostas, cranesbill, lavender, veronica, ivy, primroses, candytuft and spring bulbs. I guarded them from their natural enemies including my daughter whose mudpie flats were evolving into a reluctant lawn with a sandbox. My garden became her most reliable source of mud. In two years, I would reveal myself as an Angry, Covetous, masochistic megalomaniac lacking every virtue but Hope.

I'm on intimate terms with only a few other private gardens. My paternal grandfather's told a tale of Pride, shortsightedness, diligence and great gobs of Charity. Perennials didn't rivet his eye. He wanted a continuous show of color, so he grew annuals from seed and arranged them in crowded ranks around the front walk and at the base of his privacy hedge of forsythia. Orange and red were favorite juxtapositions, alongside purple, saffron and hot pink. He liked his colors vivid and he liked his flowers neck and neck, as if this richness somehow made up for his lack of it, the consequence of years of financial misses.

He always put down far more seed than he needed, so my mother would receive the excess bounty of pansies, johnny jump-ups, verbena, marigolds and petunias packed in cardboard egg cartons. (Vegetables, too, which he grew in disorderly abundance in a side garden.)

By the end of the summer, his garden wasn't so much a garden as a live tribute to his way of doing things, awful but skillful, lively but gaudy, yet entirely practical, because you can feel relatively guilt-free pulling up a limp annual whereas a dead perennial represents a kind of moral failure. The backyard was my grandfather's one perennial feat, a miniature putting green so pristine it looked as if it had been unrolled from a bolt of green velvet. There, in the shade, the eye could rest on the cement pond stocked with gold fish and on the woodland ferns that had always fanned the yard's perimeter. My paternal grandmother preferred it to the hot flashes of the front garden.

My maternal grandmother mostly grew vegetables. Hers was an example of thrift, diligence, Charity and Prudence on the one hand, Covetousness and Anger on the other. Eggplants, tomatoes, cucumbers, squash, lettuces and chard were arranged in neat rows. My grandmother, kneeling down near one of these rows, looked like a buxom Mr. McGregor with her man's shirt and hat, and my sister and I by analogy became the guilt-ridden rabbits. Whatever she handed us, we ate, pocketing sticks or stones we found lying around when she wasn't looking.

She loved roses, but never grew them, since her vegetables took what little there was of the sun in her yard and she needed vegetables more than flowers. Her concession to beauty was the zinnias she'd have my mother plant for her each spring in the sun-dappled, narrow plots that lined the drives on either side of the house. But these were homely substitutes and my grandmother took to criticizing them, ordering my mother to plant more, standing back from them in her Mr. McGregor uniform and silently cursing them for not being roses.

Of all the gardens I've known well, the one that now reveals the fewest vices and the most virtues is my mother's. (The only vice, really, is megalomania, which isn't much of a problem in a garden once you're retired.) It is a 40-year feat, revealing in equal portions the virtues of patience, diligence, thrift and Faith, Hope, Charity, Justice, Prudence, Temperance and Fortitude.

The back and front yards support species of lace cap and mophead hydrangea with dense bouquets that the local florists line up at her door to purchase each summer. Chrysanthemums are bouffant bushes, not mere plants, luxuriating evenbefore they bloom. The fenced-in back garden is divided into "rooms" of companion species that enjoy the same soil and flatter each other in habit and color. Clematis have been patiently trained on trellises

facing east. Species of dianthus spring from a rock garden. A rose I've known since I was a child still jewels a corner carpeted with pachysandra. My father has cut brick-paved paths and created secret gardens in places where sun is scarce. Their mulch doesn't come from the local garden center, but from the local beach where a species of gray seaweed is plentiful and free if you get there before Memorial Day.

Virtues weren't always revealed in my mother's garden. I remember a clothesline that squawked and flapped like a crow, rashes of crab grass and the hours my mother would spend with her back to the house (and, obliviously, to us), digging, hauling, watering and pruning during times when there was less harmony indoors. I remember her vow never to plant another crocus after chipmunks ate the ones we planted together in the previous fall. Tired of a patch of phlox subulata on the front lawn, she ripped it up to reveal a family of pee-wee and boulder marbles I had secreted underneath to keep them away from my sister.

There are still discordant themes on a small scale that you can find if you look closely. Her footpaths are perhaps more for the eye than the feet. Slugs chug along hostas, leaving tracks of slug-glue. Mildew occasionally subdues one of the younger plants. My mother throws nothing away. She keeps the failures and, over time, usually manages to prevail.

This year, my own gardens attained a new level of maturity. The south-facing perennial garden is lush but not cramped. The east-facing back garden has settled its graces into the semi-formal design I drew on paper and erased and drew again. The rock gardens brim with sedums, thymes and phlox. The ivy garden makes sense. The fairy rose border is many green evening-gloved hands offering sweets. There are enchanted corners where the sun, the soil and a lily repeat an ancient vision that still has the power to bring sensible humans to their knees. In a garden, it's what you do on your knees that matters.

As a result, we came to terms with some of the failures. The poison ivy, for example, overthrew the pachysandra and we had to defoliate the area, lift the narcissus bulbs, and begin again. Our sycamores still shed all year long, spewing seeds in white angora dust and a litter of leaves that make the air difficult to breathe. But we have time enough and Faith. I've forgiven the bottle-burier and his meek wife. I've let my daughter hopscotch through the gardens that have stepping stones. And Prudence and thrift have come to assume a more dominant role in the overall plan. Next comes Charity.

Perhaps once we've buried our vices in a garden we're free to unearth our virtues. Then we're transformed from permanent outcasts to temporary masters of our own plots. But this could take more than a lifetime.

EXPLORING WORLD RELIGIONS: The Baha'i Faith and Christ

Recent email spiritual explorers have exchanged a document produced by a longtime student of the Baha'i faith and the Bible. Though different authors would express the Baha'i principles differently, as the author himself states, we offer this commentary based on the extensive experience of the writer DAVID BLEY.

Your questions concerning the Baha'i view of several Christian doctrines was forwarded to me by ... I've given them some thought and jotted down answers based on my own research and reflection. While these are my personal views (and in no sense an authoritative statement of any official Baha'i "position"), they are the product of many years' study of the Bible and Baha'i teachings.

For any Baha'i-related points, I will be happy to provide exact citations from the authorized Teachings of Baha'u'llah; and for any Bible-related points, will be equally happy to provide any additional scripture citations as requested. I have tried to indicate sources below where appropriate; space, however, precludes a complete exploration of the profound questions you have raised.

You have asked about 1) the Baha'i view of the Bible, 2) the Baha'i view of Christ, 3) the Baha'i view of afterlife, 4) the Baha'i view of "eternal life" including heaven and hell, 5) whether the Baha'i God is the same as the Jewish, Christian and Muslim deities, and 6) the Baha'i view of sin. The answers below are based upon (and in one case, quoted verbatim from) my own book, "He Cometh With Clouds: A Baha'i View of Christ's Return" (Oxford: George Ronald, 1996).

1) What is the Jewish/Christian Bible? e.g. a collection of faith stories, history, inspired word of God, infallible word of God, corrupted, a lie? Please explain the reasoning or evidence to support your answer.

According to the teachings of Baha'u'llah, the Bible is the inspired Word of God: "The divine inspiration of the Gospel is fully recognized" (Promised Day is Come, 109). This book is the Holy Book of God, of celestial inspiration. It is the Bible of Salvation, the noble Gospel" ('Abdu'l-Baha 145). "You must know the Old and the New Testaments as the Word of God" (Promulgation of Universal Peace 201). Simply stated: The divine authority of Christian scripture lies at the core of Baha'i belief.

Like traditional Christians, Baha'is believe that the Bible's inspiration is a characteristic of the original divinely revealed texts — not of any human transcription, translation or interpretation based upon them. The earliest known

Bible manuscripts are handwritten copies, and among these early copies there exist slight differences of wording and sometimes of fact — exact historical dates and the like. Until scholars fully reconcile these minor discrepancies with each other and with the original (currently unknown) manuscripts, I would be uncertain how to answer questions concerning infallibility" of the translations we now have.

According to Baha'u'llah, however, 'all' of these textual variations are utterly insignificant. In His "Book of Certitude" He emphasizes that God has guarded the Bible from error or corruption in every important respect. The Bible therefore remains a fully trustworthy guide in all matters of fact, principle or doctrine with any bearing whatsoever on our salvation or spiritual well-being. For Baha'is this conviction is a matter of faith in God and Baha'u'llah; it is not and need not be based on human scholarship.

As a Baha'i I therefore accept the Bible's authority as binding in any discussion of Baha'i or Christian doctrine. This does not mean, of course, that I necessarily accept (or reject) any traditional interpretation formulated by church authorities or theological theorists. Baha'u'llah's teachings shine a bright light on the intended meaning of many scriptural passages that have never been fully understood in ages past.

One further point: Christian churches traditionally have regarded the Bible as the "last and only" Word of God, and have enshrined this doctrine in their creeds to such an extent that many people think of this as a teaching of the Bible itself. This cannot be so, if we take the Bible at its own word. Countless scriptures emphasize that the Second Coming of Christ is to be accompanied, in the "last days", by a fresh outpouring of the Word of God. (See, for example, Psalms 5:30, Amos 1:2, Eze. 43:2, Isa. 2:2-4, Rev. 1:13-16, Rev. 19:15 et al.) Thus the Bible itself rejects any claim to being the last chapter of God's revelation to humankind.

2) Who was Jesus Christ? e.g. a mortal prophet no different fromMoses, Mohammed or Baha'u'llah; the Son of God, God incarnate,a wise man, a good teacher. Please explain the reasoning or evidence to support your answer.

What Baha'is believe about Jesus Christ is precisely what is recorded in the Bible — no more, no less. Although we reject certain traditional dogmas which (we believe) have no biblical warrant, we take a back seat to no one in our reverence and appreciation for the Lord Christ.

I will try to answer your question in terms of the various ways Christ has historically been perceived: as God Incarnate, as the Son of God and as a member or "person" of the Trinity.

According to the Bible, Christ is that "quickening spirit" of whom John says: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was 'with' God, and the Word 'was' God" (John 1:1; emphasis mine). This verse suggests that Christ is spiritually identical with God in one sense (i.e., He "was" God) and spiritually distinct in another sense (i.e., He was "with" God). Baha'is believe that Christ "was" God in that His human personality was the dwelling-place of the Spirit and Presence of God. In other words, His human spirit -His "pure and stainless Soul" — became completely merged with the mind of God, the personality of God, the all-embracing knowledge of God, the omnipotence of God, the glory of God. God lived in Him and acted in and through Him. Thus Christ's acts were the acts of God, His words the Word of God, His knowledge the knowledge of God. To know Him was to know God, because He was, in a very real sense, God on earth.

If that is what we mean by "God Incarnate", then Baha'is believe in the Incarnation. The Guardian of the Baha'i Faith describes this station as "the complete incarnation of the names and attributes of God" in a human Vehicle (World Order of Baha'u'llah, 112). Unfortunately, the Incarnation has often been given a materialistic interpretation to which Baha'is cannot subscribe. Thus we do not believe that the actual body of Christ was somehow composed of the physical substance of God, for God has no such substance: "God is a spirit" (John 4:24). "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which born of the spirit is spirit" (John 3:6). "Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God" (I Cor. 15:50). It is of course true that Christ's human soul, as the home of the Divine Spirit, was associated while on earth with a physical body. This is what Paul means by saying: "In Him dwelleth the fullness of the Godhead bodily" (Col. 2:9). Nevertheless, the oneness of Jesus Christ and God is a metaphysical oneness, not a fleshly characteristic.

Jesus Christ also is the Son of God, both in a physical and a metaphysical sense. He is the Son of God in the physical sense that His body was miraculously conceived by the Virgin Mary through the power of the Holy Spirit. In the far more important metaphysical sense, however, He was (and is) the Son of God from all eternity. By this I mean that the "quickening spirit" or "Word" which the Bible calls Christ is a preexistent emanation from God. Thus Paul calls Christ "the firstborn of every creature: For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth ..."(Col. 1:15-17).

I noted above that the Bible speaks of Christ both as identical with God and as distinct from God. This duality

is reflected in countless scriptures with which you no doubt are familiar. Paul elaborates this mysterious paradox by praising the God, the Heavenly Father, as "dwelling in unapproachable light" where "no man has ever seen or ever can see him" (I Tom. 6:16). He explains that Christ, in His spiritual nature, is "the image of the invisible God" (Col. 1:15), "the express image of His person" (Heb. 1:3). Turning to Him is equivalent to "beholding as in a glass the glory of God" (II Cor. 3:18) — to seeing God reflected in a perfect mirror. Baha'is therefore view the Trinity as follows:

- 1. God is like the sun that is, the astronomical sun, inconceivably vast and unapproachable, its inner essence veiled by its own blazing glory.
- 2. Christ is like the sun's reflection, appearing with perfect fidelity in a polished and stainless mirror.
- 3. The Holy Spirit is like the sun's rays, which, having cast the reflection within the mirror, are shed by that same reflection over all who turn towards it.

God, the sun; Christ, its mirror image; the Holy Spirit, its rays. Note that if we look into the mirror and say, "There is the sun", or if the reflection itself should say, "I am the sun", these statements are absolutely true in their intended meaning. Yet if we also state that the solar reflection differs from the "real" sun, this statement also is true.

This view of Christ differs in certain respects from the best-known orthodox creeds. It is, however, fully faithful to the Bible as written, and it illuminates the meaning of many scriptures which, in the past, have seemed obscure or contradictory.

Please note that in the perspective from which I am speaking, 'there is only one Christ'. There cannot be two Christs, or ten Christs; Christ cannot have a predecessor, successor, substitute or replacement. He is unique, incomparable, ineffably glorious. The Bible does, however, refer to Christ as that Ruler "whose goings forth have been from of old, from eternity" (Micah 5:2). Baha'is understand this to mean that that "quickening spirit" called Christ has appeared on earth not just once, but at various times in human history, in the person of the Founders of various World Religions. We believe that in this day that very same Divine Spirit has reappeared or returned in the person of Baha'u'llah, fulfilling the Bible's promises concerning the "return" of Christ. In terms of human individuality, these Mirrors are different. But they are the same spirit, for they all are Manifestations of the One Christ.

"Astronomers said in a news conference Tuesday at NASA's headquarters that such a collision is expected to ultimately claim our own Milky Way galaxy. A nearby galaxy, the Andromeda, is bearing down on the celestial home of the solar system and the two stellar formations will eventually merge.

"'Humans need not worry,' said Brad Whitmore of the Space Telescope Institute. By then, it is expected that the sun will be a burned-out husk and the Earth, if it still exists, will be a lifeless chunk of frozen space rock."

Pope builds telescope to find 'Fingerprints of God'

The Pope has asked a team of top astronomers to try to find "the fingerprints of God" amid the chaos of the cosmos, writes Jonathan Leake.

The Vatican is jointly building one of the most powerful astronomical observatories on Earth to help search for other planets and star systems capable of supporting life.

The observatory, at Mount Graham in Arizona, will have two telescopes designed for astronomical survey work with the ability to pick out the clouds of dust and gas that can give rise to planetary systems. They may also be able to pinpoint those stars and planets on which conditions could be suitable for life to develop.

In what amounts to the most ambitious astronomical project in the Catholic church's history, the Vatican and its Jesuit partners will invest at least £3m in a powerful infrared telescope to search space in tandem with a £2m optical system now undergoing final tests.

The observatory will be used by the astronomers from the Vatican observatory, based near Rome, whose original team of 10 scientists will grow to more than 20 as the facility comes into operation. The Jesuits persuaded the Pope to part with the money after convincing him that the papal observatory, established in the last century, has been rendered useless by atmospheric pollution.

Father George Coyne, the director of the observatory, said its main work would be pure science, albeit with a theological bias. "The incarnation of Christ applies to all human activity, including astronomy," he said.

For the Vatican, maintaining a team of astronomers is seen as vital to prevent repeats of its past battles with scientists. It persecuted early astronomers such as Copernicus and Galileo, who challenged the church's vision of a universe in which the sun and planets rotated around the Earth.

The project does, however, hold some dangers for Christianity. One of the greatest would be the discovery of alien life forms, especially if they were intelligent. The Catholic church would have huge problems deciding if Jesus's crucifixion, which was meant to redeem mankind from original sin, also applied to aliens. One way around that problem would be to convert aliens to Catholicism, an idea already considered by the Pope's astronomers.

Father Chris Corbally, an English Jesuit who is the observatory's deputy director, said: "If civilisation were to be found on other planets and if it were feasible to communicate, then we would want to send missionaries to save them, just as we did in the past when new lands were discovered."



Such problems may be a long way off, but other equally powerful conflicts between Christianity and science are emerging. One centres on recent theories that the universe has no end or beginning, which would take away the need for a God to have created it at all.

The Pope's astronomers have considered such questions and have developed a theory of "speculative theology" which allows the church huge flexibility in the way it responds to new discoveries.

Under the theory, newly discovered phenomena are seen as "the fingerprints of God" and their complexity and subtlety simply reinforce God's omnipotence. It means that anything discovered by the Pope's astronomers can be used to reinforce rather than undermine faith.

Some believe the Vatican has lost its way. David Thompson, an expert in modern church history at Cambridge University, said: "It is biology that holds the real challenges, especially the idea that our behaviour is predetermined by our genes, and that means sinning is not possible. Without sin, Christianity falls apart completely, irrespective of what lies in the heavens."

British astronomers believe they have found planetary systems around four of the nearest stars to Earth. The discovery was announced at the Royal Astronomical Society in London on Friday.

Prior to the turn of the century, light was considered to be a wave with no distinguishable parts. Einstein refuted that premise, and proved that light was composed of discrete bundles or packets of quanta when an interaction of objects was observed, and he further theorized that light acted as a wave when interacting with itself.

Further studies of modern particle theories show how the observer interaction even changes the outcome of the experiment. The fact that light is both a wave and a particle depending on the mode of experimental observation, has been proven over and over, and is one of the great paradoxes of light. It is the interaction between the object and the observer that breaks the wave into a photon or particle.

"Body is movement. If it is at one speed, you smell something; if at another, you hear a sound; if at another you see a sight; if at another, you neither see nor hear nor smell, nor know the body in any way. If you made it faster and faster, in the end the moving thing would be in all places at once. That is the thing at the top of all bodies - so fast that it is at rest, so truly body that it has ceased being body at all . . . The swiftest thing that touches our senses is light. We do not truly see light, we only see slower things lit by it, so that for us light is on the edge - the last thing we know before things become too swift for us.

"But the body of an eldil (spirit) is a movement swift as light; you may say its body is made of light, but not that which is light for the eldil. His light is a swifter movement which for us is nothing at all; and what we call light is for him a thing like water, a visible thing, a thing he can touch and bathe in- even a dark thing when not illumined by the swifter. And what we call firm things - flesh and earth - seem to him thinner, and harder to see, than our light, and more like clouds, and nearly nothing.

"To us the eldil is a thin, half-real body that can go through walls and rocks; to himself he goes through them because he is solid and firm and they are like cloud. And what is true light to him and fills the heaven; so that he will plunge into the rays of the sun to refresh himself from it, is to us the black nothing in the sky at night."

Another fascinating paradox of light is that, according to science, light in a vacuum does not shine. This means that light, by itself, is invisible. Illumination is only visible to the eye if an object of our own familiarity is present. (Remember what C.S. Lewis said?) Objects, down to dust particles, must be present to reflect light to

exhibit its quality of illumination. Take away all objects and the atoms they are comprised of, and photons would be unseen. Contained and alone, light is the so-called "black nothing in the sky" as Lewis wrote.

The light we experience is here and not here. Because of the speed, photons are always passing through our world at incredible velocities, absorbed and let loose by the objects (and their atoms)of this world. Only the wave aspect of light can be observed by the naked eye. It looks to be one continuous wave, when it is also many infinite bundles or segments coming and going. Or is it because we seem to be continually coming and going that we theorize in such terms?

Perhaps it could be likened to a movie of quickly moving still-lifes, or film frames, giving the illusion of present motion. Ultimately, the movie is but a beam of light, as Yogananda noticed at a theater matinee fifty years ago. In effect, light is so fast that any and all image is the past footprint of all that we see. Literally, nothing we see is in the now and present. All that is really now and present is light itself!

Again, the passage from C.S Lewis is poignant "his light is the swifter movement which for us is nothing at all." Truth can be very elusive. All thoughts are abstracted mirrors of light, like drops of rain that make a lake, or movie stills in which we create motion drama. To become the wave of non-observation is to simply . . . be.

The greatest paradox of light comes from the graves

of its factories (stars), better known as *black holes*. Black, by the way, means invisible to astrophysics, and in my opinion, should have been called *invisible holes*. But John Wheeler had other ideas in the late sixties when he coined the term, and he was not talking to the public outside the scientific community. Thirty years later, black holes are not theories. We now know that most, if not all, galaxies have black holes at their center. This

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attraction is measured by gravity and weight, or mass. Get the science out of it, and it is obvious that the greatest light beings must be living in black holes because entire galaxies move around them! These incredible concentrations of light energy of immense proportions are the high esoteric realms of science. It is time they became known to spiritual seekers and finders.

The spiritual implications of black holes are incredible. Here, we have a resurrected state from so-called dead stars, the greatest mass objects we can observe in the universe. When a huge star dies, it blows out (possibly to a supernova) and implodes its remaining mass, only to turn invisible by its own weight or presence. Then it becomes more powerful in death, than in its lifetime as an active star. Its gravitational pull becomes so great that its escape velocity (speed it takes to overcome gravity) exceeds the speed of light.

Light is therefore captured and cannot escape the star's gravitational pull bringing time to a full stop. If we substitute gravity with presence, or consciousness, (better yet, love!) we can make some sense of this greatest of all invisible phenomena. The epitome of the paradox is evident when we consider the diminutive size at the center of a black hole. Science claims with mathematical conviction, that

this center is over a billion billion billion times smaller than the nucleus of an atom! Hence, the smallest "thing" in the universe is the most powerful. The weight (or presence) is infinite.

If you could approach this invisible center, or cross its event horizon, time would slow to a halt as you entered into an eternal now. To those of us left behind, you would mysteriously disappear. Picture an orchestra. God is the conductor.

God has composed a beautiful symphony, but unless there are instruments there will be no music. So, he gets a piano. Now he hears a strain, but it sounds rather bland. He adds a violin, bass, and drums; they learn to get in tune with each other and produce a sound that is pleasant but has limited potential. He adds more and more instruments - cellos, harps, guitars, oboes, flutes, trumpets, trombones, saxophones, horns, clarinets, cymbals, and xylophones. At first they all hit wrong notes, but as each finds his key and learns to harmonize with the others together they produce a much richer, deeper and more beautiful sound than the three basic instruments alone. Now God REALLY has something to conduct.

Each instrument alone falls short compared with how it sounds in concert with all the others. Each instrument is unique; an oboe can never sound like a flute, a trumpet will never be a xylophone. And how dull to have an orchestra composed entirely of pianos, all playing the same note at the same time!

And so it is with RACE on our planet. We have all the components of the orchestra but we have not yet learned how to play together, let alone to allow God in as the conductor. P.584 - "The evolution of six—or of three—colored races provides certain very desirable variations in mortal types and affords an otherwise unattainable expression of diverse human potentials. These modifications are beneficial to the progress of mankind as a whole provided they are subsequently upstepped by the imported Adamic or violet race."

P.919 - "Of the six colored Sangik races, three were primary and three were secondary. Though the primary races—blue, red, and yellow—were in many respects superior to the three secondary peoples, it should be (See following page)

remembered that these secondary races had many desirable traits which would have considerably enhanced the primary peoples if their better strains could have been absorbed."

CONTACT! Apocalyptic Uncovering, Discovering, Revealing

THE URANTIA PAPERS: Spirituality, Harmony, and 'Contactual Tones'

I was recently asked to talk about an intriguing passage in the Urantia Papers on page 1199 of the Foundation edition.

5. MATERIAL HANDICAPS TO ADJUSTER INDWELLING

Supreme and self-acting Adjusters are often able to contribute factors of spiritual import to the human mind when it flows freely in the liberated but controlled channels of creative imagination. At such times, and sometimes during sleep, the Adjuster is able to arrest the mental currents, to stay the flow, and then to divert the idea procession; and all this is done in order to effect deep spiritual transformations in thehigher recesses of the superconsciousness. Thus are the forces and energies of mind more fully adjusted to the key of contactual tones of the spiritual level of the present and the future."

The key of contactual tones?

To understand this, I considered another statement from the Urantia Papers: "Harmony is the keynote of the central universe..." [301]

I like to think that "the key of the contactual tones" is found in the universal laws of harmony. Though allusions to the word harmony are generally metaphorical in the sense of 'getting along', reference to the more technical aspects of the laws of harmonics might be instructive. In these laws I find certain unmistakable patterns of divinity, what Gregory Bateson referred to as "the pattern that connects".

In this brief discussion I'll focus on the harmonic overtone scale because I think it can provide an answer to the second part of your question as well - how one could go about hearing such tones. I will therefore combinethe elements of

the two parts of your question into a discussion of a meditation practice know as harmonic overtone chanting, which reportedly produces a heightened state of awareness wherein one can hear 'the music of the spheres'. (In the Hindu contemplative tradition, such chanting allows one to enter the resonating chamber known as The Cave of Brahma - the third ventricle of the brain, where one experiences Nada Brahma, which literally means "God is sound", or "Sound is God").

I begin with a description of overtone chanting; a brief history of its origins; a short technical discussion of the overtone series; the effects of sound on consciousness; and concluding with speculation about how all this fits into the quote from the UPs above.

DESCRIPTION: Overtone chanting is sometimes described as a single voice singing in chords (polyphonic singing). That is, one can, by controlled breathing and manipulation of the voice box (using natural vowel sounds) produce an entire scale of notes and consequent melodies by sustaining a single tone, or pitch. The higher octaves of overtones produced have a ventriloquist effect, as if they were emanating from a flute some feet away. (Mongolian shamans reportedly made a good living using this technique, explaining that the flute-like sounds were spirits answering their (en)chanting entreaties).

HISTORY: Though there are many places in

the world where vocal overtones have been produced in one form or another, the particular technique that I practice and am therefore most familiar with originated in Mongolia, though nobody really knows when (and was probably inspired by listening to the natural harmonics of a humming bow string); transported to Tibet sometime around the 16th century, where it was greatly modified to produce the low guttural chanting that has made its way into various

cinema sound tracks of late; and then brought to the West by Huston Smith via a recording he made of Tibetan monks.

OVERTONE SCALE: When Huston Smith brought back his recording to MIT (where he held a chair in religious studies), he had some of the physics people there analyze it. They found that the harmonic ratios (relationships) of the overtones to one another was that of the whole number series. In other words, the natural scale of tones produced by the chanting are successive whole number multiples of the fundamental frequency of the note being chanted. Other musical scales may likewise contain discernible patterns of interval determination, but the overtone series is the only one generated from whole number quanta.

(To produce the overtone series mathematically, take the note "Middle C" vibrating at, say, 262 cycles per second. Multiplying that by the next whole number 2 produces 518 cps, another "C" or octave; multiply that by 3 produces the next note in the scale vibrating at 774 cps, a major fifth; 4 produces another octave; 5 a major third, by 6 (the 5th interval) a major 5th, etc. These overtones continue up the scale beyond the audible frequency range, theoretically up through Infinity itself.

And for those of you who like to run thought experiments about how the ultimaton, as the smallest particle of matter, can have as its nucleus the Isle of Paradise, it should be noted that there is another way of generating the overtone series. Instead of multiplying by whole numbers, the same results can be produced by dividing by their reciprocals. For instance, take a fixed string length, or even a given wavelength of energy, keep subdividing it by 1/2, 1/3, 1/4, 1/5, etc. and you will similarly produce the overtone series unto Infinity. As above, so below).

Additionally, it was discovered that these whole number harmonics match the natural resonant frequencies of the human vocal tract (known as formants). In other words, the Life Carrier design of the human vocal tract is such that it naturally amplifies the very frequencies contained in the overtone scale. Thus it could be said we were "designed" for overtone chanting.

GENERAL EFFECTS OF SOUND ON CON-

SCIOUSNESS: The roar of civilization produces stress and dis-ease. Chanting, rhythmic drumming, and singing can produce pleasant altered states of consciousness, and some claim, healing as well (aka "sound health"). Our audio perceptual bandwidth is 10 times our video bandwidth. The human nervous system operates in the audio frequency part of the electromagnetic spectrum, one reason why music has the power to soothe the soul or why fingernails on a chalkboard can make you cringe. (The Iliad makes specific mention of how the heroes of the Trojan War kept their wives faithful by leaving them in the care of the right musicians!?!).

From the Urantia Papers: "If Adam and Eve had only survived, then would you have had music in reality; but the gift of harmony, so large in their natures, has been so diluted by strains of unmusical tendencies that only once in a thousand mortal lives is there any great appreciation of harmonics. But be not discouraged; some day a real musician may appear on Urantia, and whole peoples will be enthralled by the magnificent strains of his melodies. One such human being could forever change the course of a whole nation, even the entire civilized world. It is literally true, "melody has power a whole world to transform." [500]}

SPECIFIC EFFECTS OF OVERTONE

CHANTING: A prime difficulty the Adjuster faces in contacting the human mind is due to our electro-chemical natures ("the hereditary legacy of cerebral endowment and that of electrochemical overcontrol both operate to delimit the sphere of efficient Adjuster activity" [1199]). Therefore it behooves us to investigate and implement techniques that help control and integrate our electro-chemical animal legacy,

while at the same time provide a bridge to true spiritual contact (as opposed to just dampening the neural energies by drugging the physical body with suppressant drugs, thereby dulling the brain).

Scientific studies of meditation show a definite correlation between slow, rhythmic brain activity, calm neural energies and heightened transpersonal experiences. I believe overtone chanting facilitates this process by, if nothing else, calming and centering body and mind. ("It is to the mind of perfect poise, housed in a body of clean habits, stabilized neural energies, and balanced chemical function ... that a maximum of light and truth can be imparted with a minimum of temporal danger or risk to the real welfare of such a being." [1209])

On a more speculative note, by emitting an auditory signal composed of an unmistakable cosmic mathematical pattern (think of the movie "Contact" or the harmonic intervals used to communicate with the ETs in "Close Encounters of the Third Kind") one can, in effect, make oneself known to various cosmic eavesdroppers. For instance, the overtones in bells rung in Hindu religious services are said to act as homing beacons for 'devas' and other spiritual agencies.

The Urantia Papers tell us that "The sincere religionist is conscious of universe citizenship and is aware of making contact with sources of superhuman power." [1100]. Harmonic overtone chanting can be seen as ringing extra-dimensional doorbells.

CONCLUSION: "Human consciousness rests gently upon the electrochemical mechanism below and delicately touches the spirit-morontia energy system above [1216]".

Bridging the gap between these two distinct realms should logically be found in laws applicable to both, intellectually in the mathematical laws of harmony, and experientially in meditative practices such as harmonic overtone chanting (mathematics being the pattern that connects).

And though the Urantia Papers warn us: "Always should the domains of thephysical (electrochemical) and the mental response to environmental stimuli be differentiated, and in turn must they all be recognized as phenomena apart from spiritual activities" [739], potential benefits derived from a qualified understanding of "their intimate interrelations" [739] should be worth investigating.

If the "idea procession" of our unconnected thoughts can be seen as random notes in search on an integrated theme, and the Adjuster as the orchestra leader searching for ways to harmonize them into a meaningful symphony of revelation, then practices such as overtone chanting could help "divert", or modulate, our thoughts into more spiritual "keys" by providing a kind of metronome to which we could attune our bodies' electrochemical rhythms. It is over these underlying rhythmical beat frequencies that our indwelling Mystery Monitor Maestro must "bring forth the exquisite melodies of God identification and consequent eternal survival." [1217]

Having successfully keyed ourselves to the "contactual tones of the spiritual level of the present and the future," perhaps we will discover the answer to many of the many pressing problems confronting modern-day Urantia. For it is "Only in the higher levels of the superconscious mind as it impinges upon the spirit realm of human experience can you find those higher concepts in association with effective master patterns which will contribute to the building of a better and more enduring civilization." [1220]

God, Mother and Father

Thanks for sharing your thoughts about using "sexist" language when the object is God. Here is another approach to the subject.

(Note: when I use "Mother" and "Father," I'm speaking of the archetypal qualities of the parental feminine and masculine.)

Because this is a planet of sexed creatures, every mortal born (at least so far, but not necessarily for long!) is genetically the product of a male (father) and a woman (mother). In the "normal" home, it is the child's interaction with these two people (or substitutes) which lays the emotional/intellectual groundwork for his/her future life (see UB 127:2). Mother and Father each play a distinct role in the unfolding of the child's earthly consciousness, just as Mother God and Father God each play a distinct role in the preparation of the child's spirit for the universe career.

A baby is born only after some nine months of conception and nurture within the mother's womb. After birth the child's consciousness is totally diffuse; everything the baby perceives is an extension of the baby's primitive sense of self, the "I", including Mother, Father, and all other sensory events both inside and outside the body. There is no differentiation, no "Other" or "Not I" in this primitive consciousness -- all is one, all is baby, all is "I."

Initially, Mother is the primary source of everything necessary for survival — food, face-to-face mirroring, loving relief from all discomforts and protection from all threats. She makes it possible for Baby to begin to trust the world, to feel safe

and welcomed. Because this first psychological "task" takes time, Baby's undifferentiated bond with Mother continues for some time. She does not demand a separation in consciousness from Baby, instead she nurtures it in order to provide a sense of dependency and trust which lays the groundwork for a safe introduction of the "Other" into Baby's world.

Not so with Father. He is the first instance of "Other" to the baby. Unlike the safe "I" environment provided by Mother, Father intrudes upon the child's primitive, all-encompassing "I" consciousness and forces the recognition of "Other" - something that exists outside of the safe, secure, undifferentiated experience of the baby from "the beginning of time." Mother stays near, nurtures, and invites the baby to participate in the "I" bond of benignly diffuse consciousness; Father comes and goes, and this repetition forces Baby to recognize that there is more to life than just "I." There is also "Not I" or "Other.."

When Father comes into Baby's presence, he brings invitations to explore the unknown world of "Other," which requires that the child begin to leave the safety of Mother's nest to "go out into the world" and begin mastering it. This is why Father's attitude toward the child is so crucial. He is responsible for taking the child from the security of Mother's safe refuge and into the strange, unfamiliar world.

If he is kindly but strong, reliably present but not overwhelming, assertive but affirming, challenging but properly protective, he gives the child a sense of being welcomed and capable of participating in the big outside world. If the father is punitive, overly critical, unreliable, overwhelming, and generally unaffirming, the child learns that s/he is incapable of entering into, much less

thriving in, the outer world. The world (universe) universe becomes a place to fear and retreat from, rather than a place to trust and explore.

Isn't this what the Fatherhood and Motherhood of God is about? As children of God, we need the nurture of both immanent Mother and transcendent Father, but each parental figure provides us with the proper nurture at different stages of growth. God the Father, as transcendent "Other", can never give us the womb like safety of the feminine, diffuse "I" consciousness, which initially provides the safe container for a gentle awakening into a fuller "Other" awareness. God the Mother as immanent "I" can never embody the masculine "Other" consciousness which motivates the journey from the mother's protective nest into the vast world and universe.

We need God both as Mother and as Father. While Mother God initiates us into life through the initial stages of animal "I" consciousness (using the adjutant mind spirits), Father God prepares the way for adventure out into the vast and unknown universe by indwelling us as the divine "Other" (Adjuster) when we are ready for such an indwelling.

Finally, from this growth of consciousness perspective, we can argue that God as Father is the ultimate attainment of the children of God. Who could be satisfied attaining identification with God as Mother only? Perhaps this is what is meant by the lure to finaliter status - we must leave the safety and security of our earth/mansion world womb and the Mother Spirit's adjutant mind spirits when we fuse with the Father fragment. This fusion designates that we have attained readiness for travel into the unknown future with an "I-Other" consciousness adequate to guide us through the great unknown. (This would be the acme of Martin Buber's "I-Thou" consciousness, I think.)

But Mother is not left behind. She accompanies and cares for us via the Local Mother Spirit and then by the Eternal Mother Son. Eventually, we are promised, we attain the ultimate stretch across time and space and into eternity, fulfilling our child relationships first with God as Mother, and then with God as Father who, as the final, complete, and replete "Other," acknowledges our attainment of personality (relational) perfection and welcomes us Home.

Does God Get Angry?

Question for Bible scholars: When the authors of the Bible speak of God's anger and his causing disasters to fall on the people, are they speaking of God actually doing it, or is anger represented as Satan or other fallen beings being responsible. I've checked different versions -- King James, Modern Language, Living Bible, Revised Standard and they all are the same in this particular case.

For example: 2 Samuel 24: 1.....And again the anger of the Lord was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say "Go, number Israel and Judah".

Then in 1 Chronicles 21:1.... And Satan stood up against Israel and provoked David to number Israel.

Same incident -- written by different authors

I know there are many contradictions and error in the Bible but this one is the one that continually sticks in my mind as to what the people of those days may have recognized as God's anger. How many other times in the Bible when God's anger is written could it apply to Satan's influence and not God himself.

An email reply from Paul Premsager:

The Urantia Papers say,' the eternal God is incapable of wrath and anger in the sense of these human emotions and as man understands such reactions' (p.57).

God is self-existent and, and he is devoid of all

anger and enemity; he is immortal and infinite'(1442).

Jesus simply would not accept explanations of worship and religious devotion which involved belief in the wrath of God or the anger of the Almighty.(1378)

The contradiction that you pointed out regarding ordering of the census of Israel by David was addressed by Jesus himself in paper 142, section 3, wherein he resolves this by describing the evolving concept of God. The preceding section is entitled "God's Wrath," the subject of your post.

The Bible has many passages and phrases that are troubling to many an honest soul. While God's wrath is one of them there are even more troubling phrases such as "God repented".

The Urantia Papers enlighten us in this matter: 'The Universal Father does not repent of his original purposes of wisdom and perfection' (p.35).

The Bible and the Urantia Papers contradict each other on many, many points. This notwithstanding, they are complementary to each other in substance.

When Jesus lived on the earth he studied the Torah ,Prophets and theWritings (Hebrew Scriptures) diligently and quoted them extensively in his teaching to make his points. He had committed many portions of it to his memory, and during his crucifixion he was repeating some of them before he died.

Jesus certainly was not turned off by the troubling passsages of the Bible: he simply did not accept those passages that portrayed God as vengeful and and wrathful. In his life of revealing the Universal Father he showed the loving character of God.

If the Creator son was so respectful of the Bible

we ought not treat it lightly.

To return to your question, if Satan was responsible for the instances where the Biblical authors attributed calamities to God's wrath. I personally do not think so. The Urantia Papers say, 'The devil has been given a great deal of credit for evil which does not belong to him'. (p. 610)

"If we know God, our real business is to so live as to permit the Father to reveal himself in our lives, and thus will all God seeking persons see the Father and ask for our help in finding out more about the God who in this manner finds expression in our lives." Urantia Papers - 132-7

Did Angels Visit Washington at Valley Forge?

This is a reprint of a newspaper article first published in the NATIONAL TRIBUNE in 1859, and later reprinted in THE STARS AND STRIPES newspaper owned by the NATIONAL TRIBUNE, in 1931 with the latest printing on December 21, 1950.

The vision was related to a reporter named Wesley Bradshaw by an officer named Anthony Sherman, who served under General Washington at Valley Forge. In the vision, Washington sees three great trials to overtake the Union -- the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, and the greatest threat, a war fought on the soil of the United States near the time of Jesus' return to reign on the earth.

The last time I ever saw Anthony Sherman

was on the Fourth of July, 1859, in Independence Square. He was then ninety-nine years old, and becoming very feeble. But though so old, his dimming eyes rekindled as he gazed upon Independence Hall, which he came to visit once more. "Let us go into the hall," he said. "I want to tell you of an incident of Washington's life — one which no one alive knows of except myself; and if you live, you will before long see it verified.

"From the opening of the Revolution we experienced all phases of fortune, now good and now ill, one time victorious and another conquered. The darkest period we had, I think, was when Washington, after several reverses, retreated to Valley Forge, where he resolved to spend the winter of 1777. Ah! I have often seen the tears coursing down our dear commander's care-worn cheeks, as he would be conversing with a confidential officer about the condition of his poor soldiers.

You have doubtless heard the story of Washington's going into the thicket to pray. Well, it was not only true, but he used often to

pray in secret for aid and comfort from God, the interposition of whose Divine Providenc brought us safely through the darkest days of tribulation.

"One day, I remember it well, the chilly winds whistled through the leafless trees, though the sky was cloudless and the sun shonebrightly, he remained in his quarters nearly all the afternoon alone. When he came out, I noticed that his face was a shade paler than usual, and there seemed to be something on his mind of more than ordinary importance. Returning just after dusk, he dispatched an orderly to the quarters of the officer I mention, who was presently in attendance.

After a preliminary conversation of about half an hour, Washington, gazing upon his companion with that strange look of dignity which he alone could command, said to the latter:

"I do not know whether it is owing to the anxiety of my mind, or what, but this afternoon, as I was sitting at this table engaged in preparing a dispatch, something seemed to disturb me. Looking up, I beheld standing opposite me a singularly beautiful female.

"So astonished was I, for I had given strict orders not to be disturbed, that it was some moments before I found language to inquire into the cause of her presence. A second, a third, and even a fourth time did I repeat my question, but received no answer from my mysterious visitor except a slight raising of her eyes.

By this time I felt strange sentiments spreading through me. I would have risen, but the riveted gaze of the being before me rendered volition impossible. I assayed once more to address her, but my tongue had become useless, even thought itself had become paralyzed. A new influence, mysterious, potent, irresistible, took possession

of me. All I could do was to gaze steadily, vacantly at my unknown visitor.

"Gradually, the surrounding atmosphere seemed as though becoming filled with sensations and luminous. Everything about me seemed to rarify, the mysterious visitor herself becoming more airy, and yet more distinct to my sight than before. I now began to feel as one dying, or rather to experience the sensations which I have sometimes imagined accompany dissolution. I did not think, I did not reason, I did not move; all were alike impossible. I was only conscious of gazing fixedly, vacantly at my companion.

"Presently I heard a voice saying, 'Son of the Republic, look and learn,' while at the same time my visitor extended her arm eastwardly. I now beheld a heavy white vapor at some distance rising fold upon fold. This gradually dissipated, and I looked upon a strange scene. Before me lay spread out in one vast plain all the countries of the world — Europe, Asia, Africa, and America. I saw rolling and tossing between Europe and America the billows of the Atlantic, and between Asia and America lay the Pacific. 'Son of the Republic,' said the same mysterious voice as before, 'look and learn.'

"At that moment I beheld a dark, shadowy being, like an angel floating in mid-air, between Europe and America, dipping water out of the ocean in the hollow of each hand. He sprinkled some upon America with his right hand, while with his left hand he cast some on Europe. Immediately a dark cloud raised from these countries and joined in mid-ocean. For a while it remained stationary, and then moved slowly westward, until it enveloped America in its murky folds. Sharp flashes of lightning passed through it at intervals, and I heard the smothered groans and cries of the American people.

"A second time the angel dipped water from the ocean, and sprinkled it out as before. The dark cloud was then drawn back to the ocean, in whose heaving billows it sank from view. A third

time I heard the mysterious voice saying, "Son of the Republic, look and learn." I cast my eyes upon America and beheld villages and towns and cities springing up one after another until the whole land from the Atlantic to the Pacific was dotted with them. Again I heard the mysterious voice say, 'Son of the Republic, the end of the century cometh, look and learn.'

"At this the dark, shadowy angel turned his face southward, and from Africa I saw an illomened spectre approach our land. It flitted slowly over every town and city. The inhabitants presently set themselves in battle array against each other. As I continued looking, I saw a bright angel, on whose brow rested a crown of light, on which was traced the word "Union," bearing the American flag, which he placed between the divided nation, and said, 'Remember ye are brethren.' Instantly the inhabitants, casting from them their weapons, became friends once more and united around the National Standard.

"And again I heard the mysterious voice saying, 'Son of the Republic, look and learn.' At this the dark, shadowy angel placed a trumpet to his mouth and blew three distinct blasts; and taking water from the ocean, he sprinkled it upon Europe, Asia, and Africa.

"Then my eyes beheld a fearful scene: from each of these countries arose thick, black clouds that were joined into one. And throughout this mass there gleamed a dark red light by which I saw hordes of armed men, who, moving with the cloud, marched by land and sailed by sea to America, which country was enveloped in the volume of the cloud. And I dimly saw these vast armies devastate the whole country and burn the villages, towns, and cities that I beheld were springing up.

As my ears listened to the thundering of the cannon, clashing of swords, and the shouts and cries of millions in mortal combat, I heard again the mysterious voice saying, "Son of the Republic, look and learn." When the voice had ceased,

the dark, shadowy angel placed his trumpet once more to his mouth and blew a long and fearful blast.

"Instantly a light as of a thousand suns shone down from above me, and pierced and broke into fragments the dark cloud which enveloped America. At the same moment the angel, upon whose head still shone the word "Union," and who bore our national flag in one hand and a sword in the other, descended from the heavens, attended by legions of white spirits. These immediately joined the inhabitants of America, who I perceived were well-nigh overcome, but who immediately, taking courage again, closed up their broken ranks and renewed the battle.

"Again, amid the fearful noise of the conflict, I heard the mysterious voice saying, "Son of the Republic, look and learn." As the voice ceased, the shadowy angel for the last time dipped water from the ocean and sprinkled it upon America. Instantly the dark cloud rolled back, together with the armies it had brought, leaving the inhabitants of the land victorious.

"Then once more I beheld the villages, towns, and cities springing up where I had seen them before, while the bright angel, planting the azure standard he had brought in the midst of them,

cried with a loud voice, 'While the stars remain, and the heavens send down dew upon the earth, so long shall the Union last.' And taking from his brow the crown on which was blazoned the word "Union," he placed it upon the Standard, while the people, kneeling down, said, 'Amen.'

"The scene instantly began to fade and dissolve, and I at last saw nothing but the rising, curling vapor I at first beheld. This also disappearing, I found myself once more gazing upon the mysterious visitor, who, in the same voice I had heard before, said, "Son of the Republic, what you have seen is thus interpreted: Three great perils will come upon the Republic. The most fearful is the third, passing which the whole world united shall not prevail against her. Let every child of the Republic learn to live for his God, his land, and the Union."

With these words the vision vanished, and I started from my seat, and felt that I had seen a vision wherein had been shown me the birth, progress, and destiny of the United States."

"Such, my friends," concluded the venerable narrator, "were the words I heard from General Washington's own lips, and America will do well to profit by them."

A TIME OF REVELATION ... and a look at two of them

A professor, scholar, author and spiritual seeker shares his thoughts on our pivotal times, and two book-form spiritual revelations that he believes altogether compatible in their universe views.

From a religious or spiritual perspective, we are living in a truly extraordinary age - a time of revelation. Revelation occurs in two quite distinct ways. The first of these is through personal experience, whereby the insights and understanding of receptive individuals are enriched and expanded. This type of revelation is ongoing and has no doubt always been an aspect of human experience.

Our personal experiences of revelation may sometimes be more in the realm of feelings rather than in the mind. These are usually recognized as our most wonderful life experiences when we feel joy, happiness, peace, or love. These may be no more than brief glimpses, those special instances that you wish would last forever, when there is momentary clarity and understanding. The source of these revelations is your inner Voice, your internal Teacher, the spark of divinity within your mind and heart.

The second type of revelation occurs on a vastly broader scale and at specific times in evolution, sometimes referred to as epochs, important or noteworthy periods in history. These revelations are the functions of celestial personalities or agencies and have the purpose of providing both information and inspiration for anyone who is receptive to them. The life and teachings of Jesus provide the most well known example of such an epochal revelation.

At this time, a massive outpouring of spiritual information is being channeled through a host of individuals. It is difficult to stay abreast of it all and then to sort it out to discover what rings true, what contains meaning and has value. Perhaps the best test is your own personal truth filter, those inner feelings of clarity associated with personal revelation.

This is the approach I have taken in evaluating and studying The Urantia Book (UB) and A Course in Miracles (ACIM). It is the presence of these two works that makes this truly a time of revelation, an epoch as extraordinary as the period of Jesus' life on earth two thousand years ago.

I am assured that the UB and ACIM are pure and authentic written revelations, and my purpose here and now is to share some information and observations about each of these with you. First of all, I have selected some quotations about revelation directly from these sources.

The UB refers to two types of revelation when it states:

"Revelation as an epochal phenomenon is periodic; as a personal human experience, it is continuous."

In reference to personal revelation, ACIM states that such revelation is "literally unspeakable because it is an experience of unspeakable love" and "...revelation is an experience of pure joy".

In a more general vein, ACIM states: "Revelation unites you directly with God." A similar passage in the UB states that "revelation successfully bridges the gulf between the material and spiritual...between man and God".

I acquired the UB in 1970 and, while reading it, gradually realized that it is precisely what it purports to be - a major revelation for our planet, which is referred to as Urantia. During the next several years, I studied the book, met other readers, and taught a college course based on the book. In 1974, I was invited by the World Future Society to give a talk about the UB. In that talk, I chose the following remarks to introduce the book.

"Suppose that, by some technique, the very highest, most perceptive and truthful human insights could be collected and then formulated into a consistent rendition for study and analysis. The source of each gem of wisdom would be relatively unimportant; each would find its proper place in the whole by withstanding the tests of truth, beauty and goodness on as many levels of reality as the current evolving consciousness of man has experience for evaluation

Suppose, further, that some new information is made available for transition, for completion of partial concepts, and for extensions within the grasp of human understanding. Would the populace of this beleaguered little planet be able to adjust to the new levels of both understanding and responsibility? I regard both the supposition and the question as being of the utmost importance because, incredibly, what I am describing has occurred!

I am speaking about The Urantia Book, an unprecedented, altogether astounding, and totally unique work that will one day be recognized as one of the most important documents ever to appear in the history of mankind on this planet. I shall hereafter attempt to refrain from further exclamatory adjectives or overextended praise. I cannot possibly do justice to the phenomenon that is the UB; and, furthermore, this treatise can stand on its own merits with no need of supporting rhetoric."

My experience with ACIM has been equally powerful. Although I read an article about ACIM soon after it was published in 1975, I did not begin reading and studying it in depth until 1986.

In a preface, ACIM is described as "a teaching device" with a curriculum that "is carefully conceived and is explained, step by step, at both the theoretical and practical levels. It emphasizes application, rather than theory, and experience rather than theology". The preface goes on to state that while it is "Christian in statement, the Course deals with universal spiritual themes. It emphasizes that it is but one version of the universal curriculum. There are many others, this one differing from them only in form. They all lead to God in the end".

Neither the UB nor ACIM can be satisfactorily summarized nor briefly described. However, I wish to make a few observations about the origins, content, and authorship of each. The UB was published in 1955, having been transmitted over a period of about fifteen years from some time in the early part of this century until 1935. The UB consists of one hundred and ninety-six papers (or chapters), is two thousand and ninety-seven pages long, and is divided into four major parts.

Part One is entitled "The Central and Superuniverses" and consists of thirty-one papers; Part Two is entitled "The Local Universe" and consists of twenty-five papers; Part Three, with sixty-three papers, is "The History of Urantia"; and Part Four, with seventy-seven papers, is "The Life and Teachings of Jesus".

While the UB was transmitted through a single human being, the authorship is attributed to a group of superhuman beings, celestial personalities united in a common mission to present this revelation in the English language to our world. According to the cosmology of the UB, the earth is known as Urantia, which is one of about ten million inhabited or inhabitable worlds at various stages of evolution and composing what is known as a local universe. Our local universe is the creation of Michael, a divine being, a Son of God belonging to a class known as Creator Sons. These Sons, according to plan, as part of the scheme of creation, are bestowed on one of the worlds at a certain stage in its evolution. Michael's chosen bestowal world was Urantia; and Michael lived and went through the experience of human death as Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus was, literally, Son of Man and Son of God.

The UB also informs us that approximately one hundred thousand local universes comprise a superuniverse, of which there are seven. This represents about seven trillion inhabited or inhabitable planets on which dwell an extraordinary variety of types of beings with the common characteristic of being of one family, the family of God,

the Universal Father.

The UB describes a vast array of cosmological data while at the same time presenting a consistent, highly intelligent and insightful philosophy of life and reality. One vital thread concerns not only the origin and nature of mortal, planetary beings, but also their potential ascendant destiny. There is every assurance that each unique human personality has the capacity to survive physical death and to exist on successively higher levels of awareness, growing as in immortal soul, formed by human and divine partnership, to a fully realized spirit. Thus, Jesus' teachings of eternal life achieve new dimensions of literal truth by this expanded message.

ACIM, available in a single soft-cover volume since 1985, was originally published in 1975 as three hard-bound volumes. These are: the Text, comprising six hundred and twenty-two pages; the Workbook for Students, 478 pages; and an 88- page Manual for Teachers.

The content of the ACIM was transmitted over a period of about eight years, from 1965 to 1973. A preface briefly explains in three short sections: "How It Came", "What It Is", and "What It Says". Thus, the reader is immediately given some helpful information about the work itself. The author, the guiding Spirit-Voice of ACIM, is none other than Michael, our Creator Son, speaking again as Jesus. In many instances, he addresses the reader in the first person, leaving no doubt as to his identity. In an early section of the Text, he comments specifically about revelation as follows: "Revelations are directly inspired by me because I am close to the Holy Spirit, and alert to the revelationreadiness of my brothers. I can thus bring down to them more than they can draw down to themselves. The Holy Spirit mediates higher to lower communication, keeping the direct channel from God to you open for revelation.'

As for the purpose of these revelations, the UB states that "Revelation is a technique whereby ages upon ages of time are saved in the necessary work of sorting and sifting the errors of evolution from the truths of spirit acquirement"; while ACIM states that "revelation saves time".

The UB also makes an interesting distinction between evolutionary religion and revealed religion and then states: "It is a part of the plan of the universe that, sooner or later, evolutionary religion is destined to receive the spiritual expansion of revelation."

The UB also states: "In science, God is the First Cause; in religion, the universal and loving Father; in philosophy, the one being who exists by himself, not dependent on any other being for existence but beneficently conferring reality of existence on all things and upon all other beings. But it requires revelation to show that the First Cause of science and the self-existent Unity of philosophy are the

God of religion, full of mercy and goodness and pledged to effect the eternal survival of his children on earth."

There are interesting, intriguing parallels between the UB and ACIM. Each was transmitted verbatim through a single individual who did not interfere or attempt to contribute his or her own ideas or views. Neither book has any claim of human authorship. I find no contradictions or inconsistencies in either work; in fact, each is a virtually flawless presentation, as logical as it is beautiful. They are equally authoritative and uplifting. I find them to be mutually supportive and compatible. I have carefully read each of them several times, including going through the lessons in the ACIM Workbook on a daily basis for a year as it suggests. Each time I re-read something in either work, I find new depth and gain higher understanding.

An important concept that occurs throughout both the UB and ACIM concerns each individual's inner spiritual guidance. The references in ACIM to the Voice for God, Teacher, Guide, and Mediator closely parallel the UB's commentary on what is referred to the Thought Adjuster. ACIM tells us of "the Teacher Who instructs in quiet, speaks of peace, and gives our thoughts whatever meaning they may have". The UB informs us that: "The great goal of human existence is to attune to the divinity of the indwelling Adjuster ..." and notes that we should: "Trust all matters of mind beyond the dead level of consciousness to the custody of the Adjusters."

I am confident that the UB and ACIM will stand the test of time; in fact, both are ahead of their time in the sense that there seems to be no widespread higher consciousness prepared to recognize them. The UB, specifically, may be intended for future generations; but it has appeared at this time to acquire a readership from which teachers and leaders will arise. ACIM may have a more immediate mission although it is esoteric and presents a system of thought that is in direct opposition to the thinking and the ways of the material world. However, both the UB and ACIM should ultimately prove to be as persuasive as they are compelling to a serious and open-minded reader.

What an incredible wealth of good fortune in our lifetime to have these two sources of truth! While ACIM speaks the counsel of Jesus, the UB provides new information concerning the life on earth of this Son of God. The UB offers details about the cosmos and our role in it; while ACIM exhorts us to love and to forgive. Where the UB enlightens us intellectually, ACIM uplifts us spiritually. Each has the capability, in the words of ACIM, to "save thousands of years" in our progress towards, in the words of the UB, the "days of light and life". Together, infused as they are with the Holy Spirit, the potentials are awe-inspiring. May we extend these by seeking and doing the Will of God in our lives!
