

Love energy readings: Love multiples into more Love

One morning, Farmer Brown went out hunting with his dog, Spot. They came to a small valley surrounded by hills on three sides. There was a bear on the other side of one of the hills. Farmer Brown and Spot happen to have been downwind of that bear. Spot knew the bear was there. Farmer Brown did not.

Was Spot psychic?

Was Spot prophetic?

Was Spot channeling the bear?

I say Spot is gifted with a heightened sense of awareness. By whatever name we call the heightened awareness, its value and meaning is still the same. Its value to Spot and the Farmer is dependent upon Spot's skill in being able to relate and integrate what he has perceived, accurately. Does Spot relate what he has perceived with 'bear," big brown thing with claws and big teeth? Does Spot relate what he has perceived with "bunny," little fuzzy thing with puffy cottom tail? The effectiveness of Spot's integration means the difference between being dinner and having dinner. Therein lies the value of his awareness.

We have learned to be wise consumers when it comes to things we put into our selves. We look past the labels and focus on the nutritional value of the contents. I implore we do the same with messages of awareness. It does not matter what "it" is called. It only matters if "it" is beneficial and life promoting.

I ask we claim resonsibility for the integration of our own thoughts. Our emotions are our own creations. There is no one else to blame for what we feel, except ourselves. What we are going to feel is a result of how we have willfully chosen to perceive. For example, the message of school closings, will be experienced by the kids as, "yipee." It will be experienced by mom entirely different, "oh no." The different emotional states are due to differences in how they have chosen to perceive the situation.

I found when I am experiencing such states as anger, irritation and offense, I am perceiving from a focus of fear. In order for me to create the experience of "offense." I first would have to have perceived a threat. Threat relates to emotional security and is only possible to experience when we have chosen to place our security on material conditions and circumstances. When our emotional security is placed on material conditions, then are we motivated to do our best to control and manipulate these conditions, through means of force, applied physically, emotionally and mentally. Perspectives such as this create attitudes of arrogance, righteousness and supremacy towards our fellows..

A faith child of God needs no one else's agreement to feel emotionally secure. That feeling of security, is a natural result of such faith. A child of fear thinks to make up for quality with quantity, always seeking the agreement of others ... as if doubt added together would equal faith.

I beseech all of us to examine the concept of being self governing, as it applies to our emotions and thoughts. Emotions are the creations of our thoughts. Our thoughts are dependent upon our choice to value faith or fear. Faith brings the qualities of Love into our lives. Love is an attractive power. It needs no force to be appreciated. Nor does it need any proponents of force, to be effective.

I am a faith child of a Loving Father. I adore my Father, because he is so adorable. How could I help not love a Father whose understanding, compassion, wisdom and forgiveness are so allencompassing? If my daddy tells me, "Don't play with fire" and, I choose to ignore his guidance, then the pain I experience is a result of my ignorance concerning the nature of the fire. My pain is not a punishment from daddy for disobedience. Daddy does not utilize such tactics as fear and retributuion. These tactics are only required by beings lacking in genuine virtue of character. And my daddy... is the epitome of ALL virtue.

Love is an attractive power. When we are loving and lovable, then love is what we attract. Fear is repulsive. When we act in fear, when we act in belief we are seperate from God's all encompassing Love, we attract repulsion

and abandonment. It is just a matter of choice. A choice of how we are going to relate to the universe. Are we going to relate in cooperation with or in conflict with?

What is it that motivates you in this life, and how well does it work to help you to feel Fulfilled and Loved?

(from the Urantia Papers - Paper-103 Section-1) The unity of religious experience among a social or racial group derives from the identical nature of the God fragment indwelling the individual. It is this divine in man that gives origin to his unselfish interest in the welfare of other men. But since personality is unique—no two mortals being alike—it inevitably follows that no two human beings can similarly interpret the leadings and urges of the spirit of divinity which lives within their minds. A group of mortals can experience spiritual unity, but they can never attain philosophic uniformity. And this diversity of the interpretation of religious thought and experience is shown by the fact that twentieth-century theologians and philosophers have formulated upward of five hundred different definitions of religion. In reality, every human being defines religion in the terms of his own experiential interpretation of the divine impulses emanating from the God spirit that indwells him, and therefore must such an interpretation be unique and wholly different from the religious philosophy of all other human beings.

The Sermon

What is it that motivates you in this life, and how well does it work to help you to feel Fulfilled... and Loved?

I would like to suggest that, the most Powerful Motivator, perchance even the Only motivator, is the innate need to be Loved. It is well nigh Universal to all Life... Every Living thing responds to an environment of Love... Every Living thing thrives in an environment of Love.

Earth, barring any negative influence from humans,

reflects the loving watchcare of the Supreme Being. To creatures such as Us, it may on occasion seem violent or cruel, but the symmetrical beauty of un-compromised Nature is undeniable.

For my purposes today, let us deal with domesticated life, and that life which is distinctly influenced by humanity. Plants, devoid of self mobility, cannot go out and actively seek love. And yet, which of us cannot recognize the difference between a plant or garden that has been lovingly nurtured and one that has been neglected? Pets and domesticated animals are mobile and have the ability to actively seek love, and according to their nature and intrinsic temperaments, do just that. Which of us cannot recognize the difference between an animal that has been lovingly nurtured and one that has been neglected?

What about children? Again, which of us cannot recognize the difference between a child that has been lovingly nurtured and one that has been neglected? Using the perception of our Souls rather than of our egos, let's now consider Adults... at least as physical age qualifies them as such. Which of us cannot recognize the difference between an adult that feels lovingly nurtured and one that feels neglected?

The reason that I have cited these examples, is to bring into mind the results of Love and the intrinsically beneficial influences it provides to all living things. Everyone and everything Needs Love, and from a strictly Human standpoint, it is the one necessity of life that so few show evidence of having it in sufficient quantities.

This "perceived" deficiency is what causes to become manifest in humankind, the quest to become Lovable. Here is where the greatest of human confusion exists. What is it that truly makes one lovable? You might think, in observation of the outward behavior of the majority of people, that it is the accumulation of material things or the acquisition of knowledge, title or power which makes one lovable.

The dominant amount of time certainly appears to be spent on those things. Now is that because they actually satisfy the urge to be loved and the craving to be lovable? Or is it that ultimately they leave one with a feeling of inadequacy and of unfulfilled need... perpetuating yet another futile drive towards misplaced motivations? Certainly we must have the things that our physical existence requires for it's survival, and everyone deserves a sufficient level of comfort and entertainment, but how wise is it to pursue them with overmuch fervor and devotion and spend such comparatively little time in pursuit of the things that have

value to our souls and to our spirits?

If you wish to be loved unconditionally, then Love Unconditionally. If you would desire to be served unselfishly, then Serve Unselfishly. If you would Truly be Lovable, then go directly to the Original Source of Love, for there alone will you experience the absolute of Lovability.

New Physics ... New Theology: Bridging a Gap

I just completed reading a fascinating book by John Polkinghorne called the "New Physics, New Theology". Here is a brief overview on my take on the book.

The West is entering a new chapter in its intellectual history, and Polkinghorne is one of a handful of scientists who have already, so to speak, managed to read several pages ahead in the text.

"Belief in God in an Age of Science" is no mere rehash of the tired science-religion controversy. Rather, this short volume, based on the Terry Lectures at Yale, explores the sweeping consequences of recent revolutions in science for the conflict between skepticism and faith.

Those familiar with Polkinghorne—an eminent Cambridge University physicist who also happens to be an Anglican priest—will find here a distillation of earlier reflections as well as some new argumentation. The book is worth reading not only for its many insights, but also because it presages a new style of thinking that takes us beyond not only the modern but also the postmodern—a sophisticated, scientifically informed outlook which is nonetheless animated by a firm rationally supported religious faith.

As a physicist, Polkinghorne understands what many Western thinkers without scientific training have yet to realize: that recent science has shattered the materialistic foundations of the modern secular world view. Modern philosophy from Hobbes onward has taken its bearings from scientific mechanism/materialism, from a vision of the universe as mere "matter and motion." Yet lately physics and cosmology have raced forward, leaving this older outlook behind.

One key feature of the cosmos presented by the new physics is its God-friendliness. Newtonian mechanics ultimately led to the vision of a clockwork universe minus the Clockmaker. But the more scientists have probed cosmic evolution, the more they have realized, in Fred Hoyle's phrase, that the universe is a "put-up job." For human life to emerge, the blind mechanism of natural selection was not enough; on the contrary, the laws of physics had to be programmed minutely from the moment of the big bang. An infinitesimal change in any of the physical constants would have precluded life.

Present-day cosmology therefore leaves us with a choice: either the universe was created by an Intelligent Designer, or it is a massive and incredible coincidence the likes of which we can hardly imagine. Drawing on the philosopher John Leslie, Polkinghorne writes that there are two logical possibilities: "that God is real, and/or there are many and varied universes," the latter being invisible, unsubstantiated, and probably undetectable in principle. Polkinghorne does not belabor the point. While the God hypothesis is not "logically coercive," as he puts it, it easily stands up against the alternative.

Yet Polkinghorne's interest is not in proving God's existence but rather in showing how theology can "lay claim" to an "intellectually satisfying understanding," crucially supplementing science. He also seeks to show how theology and science, in dialogues, can inform and correct each other.

His target, in a sense, is the standard modern formulation of the science-religion relationship, which ceded to science the entire sphere of objective truth and consigned theology increasingly to subjectivism and empty speculation. When it comes to science, Polkinghorne opposes naive positivism. When it comes to theology, he insists on a greater concern for objective truth.

Science, Polkinghorne emphasizes, is not a value-free but rather a "value-laden" activity. Considerations such as the "beauty" and "elegance" of theory are "fundamental" to physics; scientific discourse depends on moral virtues such as "honesty" and "generosity of intellectual sharing."

But he resists any notion that reality is "socially constructed." Likewise, he reproves some theology for unconcern with simple truth in the literal sense of that term. He advocates what he calls "critical realism" and "bottom-up" theology, favoring quite orthodox and literal interpretations of key Christian mysteries, including the incarnation, redemption, and even (as he made clear in "The Faith of a Physicist) the virgin birth.

Can the new physics beget a new theology? Polkinghorne offers a fascinating gloss on the question of free will and divine providence, noting that present-day physics—via quantum and chaos theories—has swept aside the old principle of determinism.

His most eloquent observations concern what the laws of nature say about the problem of evil, suggesting that a divine "letting-be" is needed to underwrite human freedom: "It is in the nature of dense snow fields that they will sometimes slip with the destructive force of an avalanche. It is in the nature of lions that they will seek their prey... It is in the nature of humankind that sometimes people will act with selfless generosity but sometimes with murderous

selfishness. That these things are so is not gratuitous or due to divine oversight or indifference. They are the necessary cost of a creation given by its Creator the freedom to be itself."

Theologians and scientists alike will find food for thought here, and philosophers should take heed—for John Polkinghorne's intermarriage of scientific and theological insight may well presage a new "post-secular" stage in Western thought.

CHRISTIANITY AND THE URANTIA BOOK: Tolerance ... Intolerance

I caught most of the last two hours of the Frontline Special on the historical Jesus and early Christianity. I was left with three thoughts that might be relevant to us today.

1) The Roman empire could not conceive of Christianity as being a religion because it was new. Their paradigm for "religion" dictated that religion, by definition, was ancient. So, the Christians could not be a true religion like the ancient religion of Judaism (even though they were clearly derived from Judaism), which was protected from persecution even though they did not believe in the Roman cast of gods, including the emperor. The Christians were persecuted because, since they couldn't be a religious group, they HAD to be something else, namely political. And they were persecuted on that basis.

Topic for Thought: If a group of Urantia Papers believers have a set or practice of beliefs that is new in some respects, that does not fit with a paradigm of religion totally derived through the Urantia Papers, does that automatically mean these beliefs are "false," or "evil," or a "distraction" from the principles set forth in the UB? What is the lesson here for us?

2) The composition of the New Testament, namely the four gospels, was actually a compromise between those who

wanted a *single* interpretation of the life of Jesus to become gospel, and those who wanted a plethora of gospels to constitute the canon. This compromise, no doubt, reached with the unseen encouragement of the angels of the churches, allowed neither a strict univocity of interpretation or a chaotic multiplicity of interpretations to prevail.

Topic for Thought: The struggle of the early Christians to reach an acceptable balance between a closed and narrow understanding of the Fourth ER, and a confused, self-defeating jumble of ideas, is also our struggle with the Fifth Epochal Revelation. What is the lesson here?

3) In the attempt to bring harmony and unity to the thinking and practice of early Christianity, the Gnostics were hereticized and excommunicated from the main body of believers. The Gnostic literature was much more concerned with internalizing the teachings of Jesus than they were in producing a religion about Jesus. On the other hand, the Gnostics were uncomfortable with the fact that God and man had really lived and died as one in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. They effectively rejected the humanity of Jesus Christ. So they were deemed heretical.

Topic for Thought: What if the main body of early Christians had managed to incorporate the best of what the Gnostics believed and rejected the rest, rather than throwing away the good with the bad? What is the lesson here for us? (see UB, 92:7:3)

DEMONIC POSSESSION IS IMPOSSIBLE From TODD MOODY

I saw the entire Primetime Live segment. I thought it was both pathetic and ludicrous. When a family believes in the possibility of demonic possession, then it is easy for an impressionable child to become accidentally convinced (by their parents or a dominant family member) that they are "possessed". When they thus adopt this disorder of thinking, they will consent to acting out whatever behavior they think is permitted by / characteristic of "possession".

Exorcism through faith occurs because the "possessed" includes in their thinking disorder a belief that the priest has (through the ritual) the power to "cast out" their "demon". Thus, when adequately convinced that a full exorcism has taken place, they cancel the "possessed" behavior pattern and return to the belief that they are not possessed.

Once a person contracts this disorder of "possessibility" they are susceptible to being convinced of their own possession and then acting out the consequences. The behaviors produced during the "possession" and "exorcism" phases of the life cycle of this disorder are one of the primary mechanisms of contagion which spread acceptance of the disorder to other susceptible minds.

At no time in this entire production is anyone ever possessed by anything other than the subconscious expression of a hyperactive and vivid imagination. Recovery from infection by the mental disorder of "possessibility" occurs only when one fully and completely rejects the underlying premise that one can be possessed and exorcised.

There is no such thing as demonic possession.

There are no demonic powers capable of possessing the human mind.

The normal human mind cannot invoke demonic powers and consent to its possession.

Confusion of human intent is not a sufficient condition to allow demonic possession to occur. Only total, final, irrevocable identification with cosmic insanity will permit that. Such identification is almost impossible for a mortal to achieve in the environment of a screwed-up planet like Urantia.

DOOMSDAYS OF THE DUMB From: CAROL HERREN

Some predictions in the past, that have not panned out:

1914 was one of the more important estimates of the start of the war of Armageddon by the Jehovah's Witnesses (Watchtower Bible and Tract Society). They computed 1914 from prophecy in the book of Daniel, Chapter 4.

1914, 1918, 1920, 1925, 1941, 1975 and 1994 were other dates that the Watchtower Society predicted. 1975 looked likely as it was computed as the 6000th anniversary of the creation of Adam in the Garden of Eden in 4026 BCE. They interpreted Psalms 90:10 as defining the length of a generation to be 80 years. Since 1914 plus 80 equals 1994, they predicted Armageddon would occur around that year. The latest estimate was 6000 years after the creation of Eve, for which no date can be determined with accuracy.

1953-AUG: David Davidson wrote a book titled "The Great Pyramid, Its Divine Message". In it, he predicted that the world would end in 1953-AUG.

1957-APR: The Watchtower magazine, quoted (1) a pastor from California, Mihran Ask, as saying in 1957-JAN that "Sometime between April 16 and 23, 1957, Armageddon will sweep the world! Millions of persons will perish in its flames and the land will be scorched."

1960: Piazzi Smyth, a past astronomer royal of Scotland, wrote a book circa 1860 titled "Our Inheritance in the Great Pyramid." He concluded from his research that the millennium would start before the end of 1960.

1970's: The late Moses David (formerly David Berg) was the founder of the Christian religious group, The Children of God. He predicted that a comet would hit the earth, probably in the mid 1970's and destroy all life in the United States. One source indicated that he believed it would happen in 1973.

1984 to 1999: In 1983, Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, Guru of

the Rajneesh movement, predicted massive destruction, including natural disasters and man-made catastrophes.

1986: Moses David of The Children of God faith group predicted that the Battle of Armageddon would take place in 1986. Russia would defeat Israel and the United States.

1992, David Koresh of the Branch Davidian group in Waco Texas changed the name of their commune from Mt. Carmel to Ranch Apocalypse, because of his belief that the final all-encompassing battle of Armageddon mentioned in the Bible would start at the Branch Davidian compound. They had calculated that the end would occur in 1995. After a 51-day standoff, on 1993-APR-10, 76 members died as a result of a deliberately set fire.

1997-APR-10: Dan Millar, of Surrey, BC, Canada and Bob Wadsworth of the Biblical Astronomy newsletter are two religious researchers. They are following the age-old tradition of looking for signs in the heavens for the arrival of the Antichrist, return of Christ, etc.

1997-NOV-27: The Sacerdotal Knights of National Security report that "A space alien captured at a UFO landing site in eastern Missouri cracked under interrogation by the CIA and admitted that an extraterrestrial army will attack Earth on November 27 with the express purpose of stripping our planet of every natural resource they can find a use for — and making slaves of every man, woman and child in the world!"

1997: Superdave the Wonderchemist (5) takes the magic number 1331 and adds it to 666 the "Number of the Beast" from the Book of Revelation to get the year of the arrival of the Antichrist and the end of the world. Why is 1331 a magic number? 1331 is the same backwards as forwards. It displays the unlucky number 13 when read in either direction. it is the fourth row in Pascal's Triangle, and 1331 is 11 cubed.

Sometime in late 1997 or early 1998: The 1997-JUL-29 issue of the Weekly World News carried a statement by a spokesperson of the International Association of Psychics. 92% of their 120,000 members have had the same "end time" vision.

Spokesperson Madame Vredeau predicted: A rise in religious belief. Prophets and saints will appear and lead the faithful to safety The oceans will shrink. Deserts expand. Crops will fail; there will be massive starvation Widespread emotional and mental collapse; increase in crime and violence; changing weather patterns; basic laws of nature will be disrupted Satanic demons will appear in broad daylight. War, pestilence, a worldwide plague Mankind will disappear around the year 2001 CE.

1998-FEB-26: Edgar Cacey predicted that the earth would

have a new pole during the winter of 1997-1998. Since the earth spins like a gyroscope, this would take an enormous amount of energy to achieve. That amount of energy would cause a massive disruption to the oceans and the earth's crust. That could, in turn, cause very serious, worldwide tidal waves, earthquakes and volcanic eruptions.

1998-MAR-31: About 150 followers of a Taiwanese Christian-Buddhist spiritual sect, God's Salvation Church, have moved into Garland TX (a suburb in northern Dallas) to await God's arrival. Their leader, Hoh-Ming Chen, selected Garland because it sounds like "God land". News reports from Taiwan indicated that the group plans to commit mass suicide if God does not appear.

No chick may be had without the shell, and no shell is of any worth after the chick is hatched. But sometimes error is so great that its rectification by revelation would be fatal to those slowly emerging truths which are essential to its experiential overthrow. When children have their ideals, do not dislodge them; let them grow. And while you are learning to think as men, you should also be learning to pray as children.

Since Nathaniel and Thomas had so fully approved Rodan's views of the gospel of the kingdom, there remained only one more point to consider, the teaching dealing with the divine nature of Jesus, a doctrine only so recently publicly announced. Nathaniel and Thomas jointly presented their views of the divine nature of the Master, and the following narrative is a condensed, rearranged, and restated presentation of their teaching:

- 1. Jesus has admitted his divinity, and we believe him Many remarkable things have happened in connection with his ministry which we can understand only by believing that he is the Son of God as well as the Son of Man.
- 2. His life association with us exemplifies the ideal of human friendship; only a divine being could possibly be such a human friend. He is the most truly unselfish person we have ever known. He is the friend even of sinners; he dares to love his enemies. He is very loyal to us. While he does not hesitate to reprove us, it is plain to all that he truly loves us. The better you know him, the more you will love him. You will be charmed by his unswerving devotion. Through all these years of our failure to comprehend his mission, he has been a faithful friend. While he makes no use of flattery, he does treat us all with equal kindness; he is invariably tender and compassionate. He has shared his life and everything else with us. We are a happy community; we share all things in common. We do not believe that a mere human could live such a blameless life under such trying circumstances.
- 3. We think Jesus is divine because he never does wrong; he makes no mistakes. His wisdom is extraordinary; his piety superb. He lives day by day in perfect accord with the Father's will. He never repents of misdeeds because he transgresses none of the Father's laws. He prays for us and with us, but he never asks us to pray for him. We believe that he is consistently sinless. We do not think that one who is only human ever professed to live such a life. He claims to live a perfect life, and we acknowledge that he

- does. Our piety springs from repentance, but his piety springs from righteousness. He even professes to forgive sins and does heal diseases. No mere man would sanely profess to forgive sin; that is a divine prerogative. And he has seemed to be thus perfect in his righteousness from the times of our first contact with him. We grow in grace and in the knowledge of the truth, but our Master exhibits maturity of righteousness to start with. All men, good and evil, recognize these elements of goodness in Jesus. And yet never is his piety obtrusive or ostentatious. He is both meek and fearless. He seems to approve of our belief in his divinity. He is either what he professes to be, or else he is the greatest hypocrite and fraud the world has ever known. We are persuaded that he is just what he claims to be.
- 4. The uniqueness of his character and the perfection of his emotional control convince us that he is a combination of humanity and divinity. He unfailingly responds to the spectacle of human need; suffering never fails to appeal to him. His compassion is moved alike by physical suffering, mental anguish, or spiritual sorrow. He is quick to recognize and generous to acknowledge the presence of faith or any other grace in his fellow men. He is so just and fair and at the same time so merciful and considerate. He grieves over the spiritual obstinacy of the people and rejoices when they consent to see the light of truth.
- 5. He seems to know the thoughts of men's minds and to understand the longings of their hearts. And he is always sympathetic with our troubled spirits. He seems to possess all our human emotions, but they are magnificently glorified. He strongly loves goodness and equally hates sin. He possesses a superhuman consciousness of the presence of Deity. He prays like a man but performs like a God. He seems to foreknow things; he even now dares to speak about his death, some mystic reference to his future glorification. While he is kind, he is also brave and courageous. He never falters in doing his duty.
- 6. We are constantly impressed by the phenomenon of his superhuman knowledge. Hardly does a day pass but something transpires to disclose that the Master knows what is going on away from his immediate presence. He also seems to know about the thoughts of his associates. He undoubtedly has communion with celestial personalities; he unquestionably lives on a spiritual plane far above the rest of us. Everything seems to be open to his unique understanding. He asks us questions to draw us out, not to gain information.
- 7. Recently the Master does not hesitate to assert his superhumanity From the day of our ordination as apostles right on down to recent times, he has never denied that he came from the Father above. He speaks with the authority of a divine teacher. The Master does not hesitate to refute the religious teachings of today and to declare the new gospel with positive authority. He is assertive, positive,

and authoritative. Even John the Baptist, when he heard Jesus speak, declared that he was the Son of God. He seems to be so sufficient within himself. He craves not the support of the multitude; he is indifferent to the opinions of men. He is brave and yet so free from pride.

8. He constantly talks about God as an ever-present associate in all that he does. He goes about doing good, for God seems to be in him. He makes the most astounding assertions about himself and his mission on earth, statements which would be absurd if he were not divine. He once declared, "Before Abraham was I am." He has definitely claimed divinity; he professes to be in partnership with God. He well-nigh exhausts the possibilities of language in the reiteration of his claims of intimate association with the heavenly Father. He even dares to assert that he and the Father are one. He says that any one who has seen him has seen the Father. And he says and does all these tremendous things with such childlike naturalness. He alludes to his association with the Father in the same manner that he refers to his association with us. He seems to be so sure about God and speaks of these relations in such a matter-of-fact way.

9. In his prayer life he appears to communicate directly with his Father. We have heard few of his prayers, but these few would indicate that he talks with God, as it were, face to face. He seems to know the future as well as the past. He simply could not be all of this and do all of these extraordinary things unless he were something more than human. We know he is human, we are sure of that, but we are almost equally sure that he is also divine. We believe that he is divine. We are convinced that he is the Son of Man and the Son of God.

I am convinced that I don't have the time to spend debating all of this. I'm not out to "save" anyone from their illusions, no matter how much I disagree or think they are "wrong". I will leave it up to the Recorder-Teachers to get the "facts" straight and I'll check the records when I get to Mansonia.

PERVASIVENESS OF THE SPIRIT

No thought can be made outside the kingdom. No thing can be seen without the light of God. No life can be known without illumination. For all light is of one light, all thought is of one mind, and all we see and think is known to God.

It is not possible to live outside of God. To really attempt to do so is to die. Even in the darkest night, there is the presence of God. Even the most mundane scene is illuminated with the light of the Supreme. It is not possible to look outside of God. Nothing is outside of God.

We strive to be in the kingdom. But the kingdom is here. To say that the kingdom comes through faith, is merely to say that nothing is possible but faith. Do we not have faith that this breath will not be our last? Do we not believe that this heart-beat will continue? No moment is possible without faith.

To be human is to have faith. To be in this world, is to become a child of greater faith. Faith "is," through grace. But faith "becomes," through will, through sincerity and persistence. Life cannot be, without faith. But more abundant life is possible, through more faith. As faith expands, so the universe expands. The Supreme whispers to the child of space and time, "come with me." The child of greater faith, goes.

Nor will "greatest faith" ever be reached. Which is to say, that the limits of the experience of the Supreme will never be reached. The Supreme ^ divinity shared with wo/man ^ is eternal and infinite, thus are the potentials of wo/man's faith eternal and infinite. To deny this, is to deny the omnipotence and omnipresence of God.

We are born with little faith, which makes a little world. The adventures of faith are the adventures of a greater world. First we leave the mother's breast; then we leave our father's yard; then we leave our church's neighborhood; then we may leave our nation for another; then Each of the enlarging circles of experience is found through faith. If we do not believe we can cross the street, then we cannot. Each person that lives, has faith; the question is, how much?

First we trust the mother for nourishment. Then we trust the father for shelter. Then we trust the church for guidance. Then we trust the One spirit, the spirit that was in mother, father, and church, for direction, even on the high seas of experience and adventure. We may look back and see how far we have come, and the first home we knew may be far away, and yet we keep the love of mother and father with us, and the power of the church's prayer on us.

Greater faith leads to greater things, forever. Greater faith lets us see more of the kingdom. But to see outside the kingdom is not really possible. The child of little faith may fear the dark and imagine monsters in it but these very things, however unreal, are only possible through the gift of life in the kingdom. One may be in the kingdom and not know it; this happens to many. One may not, however, notbe in the kingdom, and know it; such is only fear of the dark. To confront the monsters of illusion, is the first step of the child in the kingdom.

Even the dreariest day, even the most dismal shadows, still exist as a consequence of the kingdom. When faith is low, the light is low. When faith is high, a brilliant splendor shines all around and we can see a great distance.

That which we see from the depths of our gloomiest despondency, is still a reflection, howsoever dim and far, from the kingdom. We may choose to have little faith, but we may not choose to see with a light that does not come from God. Evil may be done, but it too is done through the grace of God and reverberates in the kingdom. It is not that we "find" the kingdom; it is rather that we "know" it. We simply look up and realize that we are in it, that it is there, and always has been, and always will be.

To see the kingdom, though, is not to see all of it. No one but God has seen the whole kingdom. We may however see more of the kingdom. This occurs through faith. Faith is the confidence to explore the kingdom. Faith is confidence in God to lead us through the kingdom. Faith is also the increasing ability to hear from God. Those of little faith hear little, those of much faith hear much.

Nothing can be seen without light. To see anything, is to be within the light. All light is One. All light comes from God. Light is the love of God. No journeying is possible without light, and the purpose of light is journeying. To see is to be blessed with the fatherhood of God (and the physically blind "see" just as well as any in this spiritual context).

There is a natural ebb and flow to human emotion, but no point is low enough that wo/man can feel, see, think,

believe, suffer, without the upholding of God or without the One light that lights the universe. We may indeed reduce our faith to a minimum; we may turn the light down until only shadows remain; we may be overcome with fear and dread; but all such things exist only because we are faith-children of God, living in the kingdom.

A mind may choose to deny that it exists, and yet it must exist in order to make that very denial. Free will may choose to use the light of the kingdom in many ways, even in foolish ways. But just because the mind can will itself to deny something, hardly means that it is necessarily so. The child says many foolish things, but one day must grow up. The child has many fears, but one day must learn to face them. It is the very love of the father that constantly urges the child to grow, to have new experiences, to overcome fear, to have faith. Love rules the universe.

What was darker than the scene of the crucifixion? Yet the kingdom of heaven was even there, as Jesus knew. Men made the crucifixion through fear and ignorance. Jesus showed that even there, in that most dark and recondite corners of existence, even in that place of fear and shadow and apparent horror, even there was the kingdom. Such proofs should not be necessary, but when fear rules the child, the father must sometimes show great mercy and tenderness. The father may even choose to suffer "unnecessarily" so that the child of fear may be shocked out of panic, and the crucifixion of Jesus was just such a shock.

Fear still rules many, but it is hardly possible for anyone to face greater fear, unbelief and enmity than did Jesus. Jesus faced the darkest fears of wo/man and showed that even there a man could find the kingdom of heaven. Certainly fear is painful, but it is hardly necessary. Certainly suffering is great, so why make it?

Whether fear is great or small, the light of the Father can hardly fail. Fear is nothing. Light is all, for love is all. The concept of darkness could not even exist except for light. The very concept of darkness proves the pre-eminence of light, if such "proof" is needed. Darkness is only a relative absence of light. Light and love do not "fail." Consciousness "is"; only consciousness that is aware of its own consciousness can fear "not being." The very act of being able to fear, indicates the truth of faith. Without faith, there could be no fear. Fear is merely a relative absence of faith. Fear proves the faith potential of the child, even as the concept of darkness proves the absolute reality of light.

ABRAHAM - Woods Cross Group June 15, 1998 "SPIRILOGISTICS" TR: Nina

I am ABRAHAM. Welcome. Greetings. How connected I feel to the cosmic mind when we all join in conversation. I can literally view the energy exchange between you. What a recharging of our spiritual batteries each time we meet. I perceive your bond with one another in this group is strengthening and helping to keep a well balanced mental attitude.

I understand the experience of the mortal flesh. Before my association with Machiventa I too had to carry on with blind faith and eternal hope that all I felt to be true was indeed true. This is your common ground. Your group is your spiritual anchor in the storm of mortal living.

Our discussions of late have been regarding living up to your highest light, making all decisions from a spiritual standpoint. Having the willingness to take action with Father's will, making Father's will living, allowing His wisdom and divine love be put into action through you, His mortal children. As you are able to put these words into practice and understand that mortal life should not be fraught with regret, do you begin to realize that you are stepping away from human emotions into a place of spirit and logic.

The life of the Master was an excellent example of spirit logic, "spirilogistics." He acted from the standpoint of His Father's will, and it at times did not run congruent with

PENTECOSTAL POWER: The Brownsville Revival

A TESTAMENT TO THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH by RON FAULK <rfaulk@nstar.net>

The Spirit of Truth is so close. Many are feeling it and have had their lives shaken and transformed. Others seem not to feel that God is drawing closer.

The Spirit that is the true spirit of Jesus is gentle, holy, sacred, loving. But those who are embraced by it are also taken to a deep humbleness, for to see the truth about our self is indeed humbling, and the power and pervasiveness of the spirit is awesome.

I recently returned from my second trip to the revival at the Brownsville Assembly of God in Pensacola, Florida. After my first experience a couple of months ago I had a deep longing to return. The Spirit of Truth is there in great power. It is amazing to experience it, and more so with thousands of others. It is like rising from a fog suddenly and being able to see far into the distance and everything around in great clarity. The Comforter, the Spirit of Truth, Jesus' presence, is so personal, so relieving; receiving it is like returning home after a long, long absence.

The blessing of the Lord is great and I am deeply, utterly grateful for his mercy and grace. He is indeed the upholder of life, the prop of our soul, the well of happiness, a comforter for eternity. I have been with eight thousand souls who, somehow with the Spirit of Truth, managed to unify and express such a sincere yearning for God's love and grace that his Spirit reflected upon us until a true and sublime spirit of worship went into and came from all gathered in an amazing symphony of expression and comfot that can't be described. It can only be experienced.

This new Spirit, or the same Spirit of Pentecost now poured forth in a new measure, has to be experienced. I believe that experience holds forth a great opportunity to change the world, and indeed the only opportunity. The world cannot be changed through mind or intellect. But if enough persons can open themselves, can believe, can receive, can experience the amazing expression of God and Jesus, then the world will indeed be changed, for anyone who has received this Spirit, unless they backslide, simply will no longer live in the old world.

I have seen people saved on the spot. I have seen in their relieved faces and heard in their trembling voices the expression of a new self, a joy not seen before, a gratefulness and humbleness absent from their lives.

Nothing is quite like seeing spiritual rejuvenation, except experiencing it. I owe God my life for the gift of the spirit. It makes all things new. The Spirit is of a greater reality, a new universe, an incredible kingdom. How can I tell about it? You must believe and experience it yourself. Everything seen, heard, felt, imagined, is different.

God of course is everywhere and the time-space presence of Jesus lives in the heart of every person. But when a few souls learn to begin to do God's will and to tune-in to the spirit and to let the spirit lead (instead of some person trying to assume authority), and when many come to worship with them, then the spirit seems to descend with a greater power and presence.

I am convinced that a spiritual hunger is sweeping the land. More and more persons are feeling the presence of God and seeking urgently for the spiritual food to satisfy this tremendous longing. Over 2,500,000 have been to the Brownsville church in the last three years.

It is amazing to see several thousand spiritually hungry souls gathered in laughter and good company, urgently seeking the spiritual presence of God. It is more amazing to be with them when the Spirit comes. That experience is refreshing, re-vivifying, more than comforting. It is clarifying. It heals. To be in the spirit is to step into a new day and a brighter light where we can see forever.

The church there holds 2,500 but for three years more people have come than that. The doors open at 6 p.m. but people begin lining up around 7 a.m. I arrived Thursday morning 9:30 am and several hundred people were already in line (this is Florida and the heat is around 100)

Even in line, during the day, a wonderful spirit is among the crowd. During four days, among perhaps sixteen thousand people, I did not hear one word of anger or protest, nor saw a single unbrotherly act, nor saw anyone seeking to lord it over others. People policed themselves, responded to the crowd monitors, helped each other out, laughed, sang, rejoiced. Also amazing is the diversity — they are young and old, radical and conservative. Largely they are of the common people.

They are, true, largely Pentecostals or those familiar with Pentacostalism (but not all). I have seen the spirit descend on the crowd even in-line during the day and seize people physically with shaking and speaking in tongues and other manifestations. During service that Thursday evening the crowd jumpedup in worship and the spirit responded in such strength that the ministers were not able to preach a sermon (and did not pass the plate — this in a five hour service). I have been there before when this happened. The crowd was seized with a desire for prayer, and for two or three hours, under the direction not of human ministers but of the Spirit of Jesus, it prayed and worshiped with joy and exultation.

The spirit at such times is manifestly suprahuman. The crowd often responds as one. As the crowd rises in prayer like the waves of the sea, healing and comfort and refreshment are made available.

Towards the end, all who wanted personal prayer and laying-on of hands were called to the altar. I have written about this elsewhere, and mention here again that many, in the hundreds if not thousands, were physically touched by the spirit, "slain in the spirit" as the Pentecostals say, and I again experienced this myself.

Personally, the more experience I have in receiving this physical manifestation, the stronger it becomes. Before one of the ministers prayed for me (and ministers are both men and women), I tried to empty myself of all desire and just accept whatever God wanted; I tried to resign myself to his will. As one might expect, this seems to make the presence of the Spirit all the more powerful. When the minister laid his hand on my head, it was as if a spark jumped into me and knocked me down. I remember saying Wow!" not in pain but in surprise at the power.

As this is happening to hundreds, the presence of the spirit is all over. Just to be there is wonderful. And to be able to express true thankfulness to God is more wonderful. The presence of the Lord is a tremendous comfort.

Some, especially those who are new to such things, do not, in a self-aware sense, seem to feel a strong "physical" presence of the Spirit, although all of these I have talked with acknowledge a wonderful and amazing "general" presence of spirit in the assembly. I should add, that I do not personally believe that being able to receive the spirit in a physical, sometimes very strongly emotional sense (some people cry or laugh with great abandon), necessarily means being more spiritual than others; the spirit has many gifts, some of this kind, some of that.

One truth the Spirit shows, is that no one has the capacity (hence the "right") to make spiritual pronouncements about others. Only God can judge, and this is because no one controls the spirit, and hence "truth," but God. The Spirit also shows than any spirit of enmity, or anger, or manipulation, or desire for preference, or self-righteousness, or pretentiousness, is not of the Spirit of Truth.

On Friday morning we arrived about 9:30 a.m. and 3,000

persons were already in line. By 6 p.m., by my estimate, over 7,000 people were there. We did not make it into the main church that evening, but went to one of the over-flow areas. The Spirit, of course, does not live in a church, nor does it come more strongly to those in a church.

That night the Spirit expressed itself in a unique, tender, and sweet worshipfulness. At one time, for twenty minutes perhaps, the crowd seemingly as one being expressed a simple, humble, joyous, very sacred-feeling thanks and praise to God; we somehow were able to feel a true, existential, appreciation for the holiness of God; and it was so joyous and comforting to be able to express this to God, a great relief.

Again there was no human direction, not even music; it was spirit-led. Later that evening, when the altar call was made for repentance, for dedication to the Lord, and to be saved in the spirit, over 80% of the crowd responded, and many,were liberated and received into the new fellowship of the Spirit of Jesus. I believe such sights mark the end of one dispensation and the beginning of another.

My friends, if you have not felt the personal Spirit and presence of Jesus, a man who lived among us, you have great things in store for you, an unimaginable gift. It will change your life. Once you feel the Spirit and see the new kingdom, there is nothing you will want more. How can it be described? These children of the new kingdom will make — are making — a new heaven and earth.

If you have not been to Brownsville, I urge you to go. The ministers and staff there still have some dogma, and as humans they are not perfect, nor do they claim to be. But they do seek after the Spirit, and they are looking always to let it lead them. And the presence of the Spirit of Truth, the Comforter, the presence of Jesus, is there.

If you have that spiritual hunger, know that it can be satisfied. The world has many deceivers and pretenders, false princes and powers, those who claim the kingdom is here or the kingdom is there, but the Spirit witnesses itself; there is no wondering about it; it is of the essence of holiness and grace and perfection and comfort; and it speaks to the heart and soul of the next and greater life. It is tremendously refreshing and revivifying. And it heals.

If 20 or 30 spiritual fires like the Brownsville "revival" could be kindled across this nation, we would change it. We would start making a new earth here and now. I believe this is happening. Join in the Spirit! Ask for it. Pray deeply and sincerely for it. Keep a constant awareness in your mind of God; constantly try to hear what the Spirit counsels you, and with practice and sincerity you will begin to hear more clearly. Be humble, and watch out for pride, for it quenches the Spirit.

Aaron: Courage on the inner level, applying that to yourself, is simply an honesty with your feelings. When you hear unsettling ideas, rather than to ignore, it could be positive to explore what it is that makes you feel this unbalancing.

When you get direction, when someone offers advice, when you receive, you have to explore the necessity of that information. If it pertains and applies to your life and you accept that it is true, then courage to make the changes and to bare yourself is needed.

I would always encourage you to not run away from who you are. It is easy to think you've got it handled and that life is so spiritually motivated when you are talking so often about such things, but yet there is a real time for growth and all of you, ALL, though ascending nicely, have room to grow. None of you will burst into a pure shining light tomorrow.

It takes courage to bring your focus back to your growth, your understanding, your frailties. Dear Brothers and Sisters of the Teaching Mission, Greetings and Salutations!

I am moved to share with you a beautiful description of one of the primary unifying aspects of the Teaching Mission, namely the experience of seeking stillness, as expressed in a Course in Miracles by the following words and thoughts. This is Lesson 125.

"In quiet I receive God's Word today

Let this day be a day of stillness and of quiet listening. Your Father wills you hear His Word today. He calls to you from deep within your mind where He abides. Hear Him today. No peace is possible until His Word is heard around the world; until your mind, in quiet listening, accepts the message that the world must hear to usher in the quiet time of peace.

The world will change through you. No other means can save it, for God's plan is simply this: The Son of God is free to save himself, given the word of God to be his guide, forever in his mind and at his side to lead him surely to his Father's house by his own will, forever free as God's. He is not led by force, but only love. He is not judged, but only sanctified.

In stillness we will hear God's Voice today without intrusion of our petty thoughts, without our personal desires, and without all judgment of His holy Word. We will not judge ourselves today, for what we are can not be judged. We stand apart from all that which the world has laid upon the Son of God. It knows him not. Today we will not listen to the world, but wait in silence for the Word of God.

Hear, holy Son of God, your Father speak. His Voice would give to you His holy Word, to spread across the world the tidings of salvation and the holy time of peace. We gather at the throne of God today, the quiet place within the mind where He abides forever, in the holiness that He created and will never leave.

He has not waited until you return your mind to Him to give His Word to you. He has not hid Himself from you, while you have wandered off a little while from Him. He does not cherish the illusions which you hold about yourself. He know His Son, and wills that he remain as part of Him regardless of his dreams; regardless of his madness that his will is not his own.

Today He speaks to you. His Voice awaits your silence, for His Word can not be heard until your mind is quiet for a while, and meaningless desires have been stilled. Await His Word in quiet. There is peace within you to be called upon today, to help make ready your most holy mind to hear the Voice for its Creator speak.

Three times today, at times most suitable for silence, give ten minutes set apart from listening to the world, and choose instead a gentle listening to the Word of God. He speaks from nearer than your heart to you. His Voice is closer than your hand. His Love is everything you are and that He is; the same as you, and you the same as He.

It is your voice to which you listen as He speaks to you. It is your Word He speaks. It is the Word of freedom and of peace, of unity of will and purpose, with no separation nor division in the single Mind of Father and of Son. In quiet listen to your Self today, and let Him tell you God has never left His Son, and you have never left you Self.

Only be quiet. You will need no rule but this, to let your practicing today lift you above the thinking of the world, and free your vision from the body's eyes.

Only be still and listen. You will hear the Word in which the Will of God the Son joins in his Father's Will, at one with it, with no illusions interposed between the wholly indivisible and true. As every hour passes by today, be still a moment and remind yourself you have a special purpose for this day; in quiet to receive the Word of God."

The Teaching Mission participants are certainly going about things in a way consistent with this loving advice. And, from my perspective, we are reaping the benefits in incredible and literal ways that are consistent with the experience described here.

What has stymied Christianity, in my opinion, is the belief that this union of God and man was only true for Jesus. But this cannot be, because we read here that Jesus offers this Bread of Life to everyone. He states that this bread of life IS his life-giving revelation to the world and his saving gift to all nations. So, THIS IS IT. THIS IS WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT. He offers this bread to everyone. He doesn't eat it by himself.

Jesus was the Father, the Infinite I AM, incarnate in the Son. I once composed a little ditty:

I the Father AM the Son; This is true for everyone.

In other words, the principle is just as true for us as it was for Jesus. Of course, we are not going to manifest or exhibit that principle as well as he did. Nor should we expect to. But the principle is the same. The question is, do you accept the principle for your own life?

The Infinite I AM conceives of himself. Each Self conception of the Infinite I AM is one son of God. Self-unity is the result of an infinite Self-conception. All infinite Self-conceptions of the Infinite I AM are equal.

However, some of them exist far more in potentiality than in actuality. Michael of Nebadon is a very well actualized infinite Self-conception, and therefore he is accorded a high place of Responsibility in the actualized and actualizing universe.

We, on the other hand, are just starting that journey

of actualization. Neverthless, the principle is the same: we, too, can accept our I AMness just as Jesus did. We won't express it as well, but we can accept it with the same faith that Jesus did.

The same I AM indwells each son. The I AM is meant to play a necessary and continuous role in your life: the I AM is the "who" of you. There is no other "who" of you. Each son IS the Infinite I AM (the Father) in a particular way. The same Infinite I AM indwells each son as the real Who of each of them.

In order to realize this, it is critical to experience that the Infinite I AM is entirely subjective and beyond all possible boundaries. The Thinker is not the thought, the Seer is not the seen, the Doer is not the deed, and the subject is not the object. Whatever we are conscious OF, is some sort of spiritual/mental/physical object, some sort of image, pattern, belief, symbol, or expression. And whatever we are conscious OF, we are NOT THAT. We are unique expressions of the Inexpressible, unique descriptions of the Indescribable—the Infinite I AM that WE ARE.

The purpose of the Age of the Supreme is to transform the I AM into the WE ARE.

Such realizations lead to the Brotherhood of God based on the Fatherhood of Man, the I AM in each man. It is the Brotherhood of God that reveals what you so aptly called "...a NEW and enlarged presentation of his saving message." What God wants to do is talk to himself, consciously.

The Infinite I AM has no one to talk to until he creates Self-conceptions with whom to talk. The Infinite I AM can talk only to the Infinite I AM; who else could consciously and appreciatively do the job? As the I AM does this, the WE ARE arises.

In my view, only the conscious Brotherhood of God, based on the Fatherhood of Man, can turn the situation around on this planet. The question is when it will ever happen, and I cannot answer that. Human evolution always proceeds at the rate of choice per capacity. Peace.

SPIRITUAL WORKBOOK: Non-Violence and Non-Resistance

How should we respond to other people's aggressive behavior? Is a stance of nonresistance like that practiced by Jesus practical, desirable, or even possible to achieve? Just exactly what limits should one set upon responding to aggressive acts by adopting a policy of nonresistance? Does it make a difference whether or not it is verbal or physical aggression?

Nature of aggression.

We should first begin by examining the nature of aggressive behavior. According to the dictionary, aggression is defined as:

1.the action of a state in violating by force the rights of another state, particularly its territorial rights; an unprovoked attack, invasion, or the like.

2.any offensive action, attack, or procedure; an inroad or encroachment.

3. the practice of making assaults or attacks; offensive action in general.

4.hostility toward or attack upon another, whether overt, verbal, or gestural.

For understanding interpersonal behavior, the 4th sense of the word aggression as hostility or attack is the one I would like to consider. An aggressive act is a behavior that is intended to hurt, harm, or take advantage of the recipient. It is a forceful act that is intended to meet the aggressor's needs at the expense of the victim.

In armed robbery, for example, the perpetrator forces the victim to give him money by threatening violence. In an angry verbal assault, there is an attempt to retaliate for a perceived wrong or injustice. A sadistic person or a psychopath will commit acts of violence in order to derive a sense of pleasure, power, or stimulation from hurting another person.

One of the problems with aggression is that it is an unjust act from the perspective of the victim. Sometimes, there is no way out for the victim of an aggressive attack and the result is pain and suffering on the part of the victim. Other times, the injustice of the act leads to anger and aggressive behavior as a means of retaliation. In the worst case aggression leads to a cycle of violence and revenge. Other times, the victim fights back in order to defend him or herself from greater harm.

What response is appropriate when you become a victim of another person's aggressive behavior? Does it depend

upon the degree of violence of the aggressive act? Should we respond to a verbal attack differently than a physical attack?

Understanding the motives of the aggressor

It is often helpful if we try to understand the motives of our fellow humans. When you are faced with an act of aggression, it can be helpful to try to understand the motives of the attacker. Is the person hurt or angry? Can I understand the reason he or she is trying to harm me or take advantage of me? Why is this person acting this way? Is there a need for money, for safety, or for shelter? Is this person suffering from a drug addiction? What is motivating this person to hurt me in order to gain some advantage for himself?

Understanding the motive of the aggressor, especially in the case of verbal aggression, is very important. When you are verbally assaulted, there is no real harm that can come to you. It's not like you will be killed if you do not take defensive action.

Normally, most of us respond to an act of verbal aggression with anger or retaliation. We have a sense of outrage that someone is talking to us in such a way. This is a situation in which turning the other cheek might be very effective if combined with an attempt to understand the motives of the attacker. You may be able to do something that will be of real help to the attacking individual if you stay calm, ask yourself why is he or she acting this way, and what does this person really need from me?

Physical violence creates more of a dilemma. If someone swings at me with a baseball bat, is ducking still nonresistance? Should I run or try to escape when someone is threatening violence, or should I expose myself to harm? Sure, go ahead and hit me again with that baseball bat, I understand that you feel hurt and that you think bonking me will make you feel better.

In an unprovoked attack, are we justified in trying to defend ourselves and attempting to minimize bodily harm? When someone is trying to hit you with a baseball bat, should you take the time to ponder their motives or should you duck? I am inclined towards ducking, escaping, then pondering the motives of the perpetrator. What would Jesus have done?

What if you witness someone else being physically attacked? Are we justified if we step in and use physical force to prevent an innocent person from being harmed? If so, how much force can we use before we become the aggressor ourselves?

There are some lines that it seems possible to draw. It is

not right to attack or hurt another person just so that my needs (physical or emotional) can be met. If someone says something that angers me, it would not be right to bonk them with a baseball bat. If someone insults me, I might feel hurt or angry, but this is not a good enough reason to start saying things that will hurt their feelings. If someone swings at me with a baseball bat, I do not think I am justified in pulling out a pistol and killing them.

If someone is insulting me, it is appropriate to discuss it with them. If I am being attacked verbally in front of a group of people, I think that defending myself by correcting misstatements or misperceptions is different than trying to get back at the person in some way.

I do not think it is wrong to duck if someone takes a swing at you. If someone is threatening me with a bat, it would be O.K. to take the bat away from them. Running away (escaping harm) is alright too. I think there are times when it is O.K. to step in and physically subdue an individual who is attacking an innocent person. We can use just enough force to stop the attack, but then refuse to beat the perpetrator senseless as an act of punishment or retribution. I think that using enough force to stop an attack on oneself would be appropriate if you are unable to talk your way out of it or escape.

Does love overcome?

The idea behind Jesus's statement that one should turn the other cheek is that love can conquer all. The person who is hurt, jealous, angry, or needy will not likely be persuaded to reexamine his or her position just because you threaten to bonk them with a ball bat. However, if you help them see what they really need then do what you can to make it possible for the person to have those needs met, this might be much more persuasive.

I know a man who has a bad temper and who has on numerous occasions struck, pushed, and otherwise hurt his wife with physical violence. They were visiting at my house and something happened that made him very angry at her. He was being verbally very abusive and this was upsetting all of us. I tried to reason with him, talk him into calming down, and tried to get him to walk away from the situation for a few minutes. This was not working so I placed myself squarely between him and his wife and was insistent that no body was going to hurt anyone. This did not work (and luckily he did not bash my teeth in).

After a half hour or more of turmoil, I don't exactly know what happened, but I suddenly hugged him and told him I loved him. I said I understood that he was in pain and that he felt angry but that I loved him anyway. This took him by surprise. He calmed down and we sat outside and talked for a couple of hours about how he could get his life better under control. Instead of threatening him,

pushing him, shoving him, insulting him, or giving an ultimatum, I gave him what he needed most. I gave him a little unconditional love.

I wish I could say that I now react to situations like this in a loving way all the time. I have not progressed that far. But, what I did learn from this experience is that love can overcome. Love is a much more potent force than anger. I could pierce the armor of his anger and his pain much more effectively with an act of love than I could by puffing up my chest and getting in his face.

When faced with aggression, especially verbal aggression, it may be more effective to return love for anger, to respond with caring instead of retaliation. What would happen if 10% of us learned how to do this? What if that led 20% of us to react this way? Would it catch on and soon we would all be loving each other instead of brutally and aggressively getting what we need at other people's expense?

Learning self-control

One thing that Jesus had that I do not have is total self-mastery. I can subscribe to the radical theory that love is the best way to respond to aggression. But, I find it hard to gain total control of my emotions. When I am insulted, when I am verbally assaulted, I react with angry words without thinking.

How can I increase my self-control so that I respond more deliberately and less automatically to acts of verbal aggression? In the long run, it is a matter of spirit dominating mind, and mind dominating matter. If I allow myself to be drawn forward by the love of God, I will increasingly be able to become more and more God-like. The more responsive my life becomes to God's will, the more I will be dominated by higher spiritual motives. As this happens, I believe I will gain greater control over myself and my emotions.

Mind mastery over matter is a process of learning and practice. Partly, I have to learn to recognize situations in which I need to change and then work at deliberately changing how I respond to these situations. It involves being analytical and disciplined. When I cannot thoughtfully respond to a threat and I end up getting angry or retaliating, what I must do is take responsibility for my reaction and interrupt the cycle of aggression/retaliation as quickly as I can. When I get out of control, I need to forgive both myself and the aggressor. Then, I can ponder what I might learn from the experience and see if there are steps that can be taken to prevent an overreaction in the future.

Self-mastery is hard work and I do not think it comes automatically. It is like learning any other skill in that it takes practice with feedback. Unlike basketball or basketweaving, self-mastery differs in that it is probably

the most important skill we will ever acquire. It is also certain that it is a task that will extend beyond this lifetime.

I think that it is possible to articulate some goals for dealing with other people's unjust aggressive acts:

- 1. Try to understand the motive behind the act when responding to the act.
- 2. It is all right to take immediate actions to avoid physical harm to self or others.
- 3 It is not wrong to tell the truth or to set the record straight when someone is verbally assaulting you. Your motive should be to tell the truth and not to get back at someone.
- 4. We should not take on the role of judge, jury, and hangman and think that it is our role to punish people who act aggressively. Punishment of the aggressor is something that must be done by judges, juries, and the proper authorities.
- 5. Love is a powerful force in the universe. Whenever possible anger, aggression, jealousy, pettiness, and selfishness should be responded to in the most loving way possible.
- 6. It is important to gain control over the automatic tendency to react to aggression with anger and retaliation.
- 7. When you fall short of your goals and find yourself reacting in a mean-spirited and aggressive way, stop as quickly as possible, learn what you can from the experience, and forgive yourself and the other person involved in the situation.
- 8. Ultimately, we will be more able to gain control of our emotions and learn to love people even when they act unlovingly towards us as we learn to be dominated by spiritual motives and strive to become more like Jesus.

It is not a matter of calling in a hired channeler and paying them; transmitting-receiving is a voluntary service that group members have to do for themselves. Some groups have one transmitter; others have a number of members who have learned the technique,

and several celestial teachers can then participate in sessions, giving lessons and answering questions.

Urantia Book study groups have been a fertile ground for the new celestial teachers since they already understand the cosmology of the superuniverse. But spiritual guides and teachers are working with many humans by many methods in these modern times, in the way they can best receive spiritual guidance. We can all only imagine the vastness of their spiritual "Correcting Time" for our planet, as we watch it unfold.

Most, but not all, of our visitors in the Teaching Mission are ascending personalities who have lived as mortals on other planets and are now in what the Urantia Book refers to as in a "morontia" form, a refined type of body mechanism invisible to our mortal eyes. Hundreds of pages of transcripts of beautifully wrought, ever-loving, instructive and very compatible Teaching Mission transcripts are being exchanged freely, on paper and via Internet.

3 — <u>Transmitting/Receiving.</u> After some weeks of real effort, I became a TR (transmitter-receiver) for our Urantia Book study group, as others had done before me. This does not imply or bestow special spiritual status, and is strictly a service for the group.

While in the relaxed alpha state, I learned to verbalize the teachers, speak words they dictated to me -- as you can as well if you choose this path. TR requires stilling your usually busy human mind, and through true worship, prayer, faith and trust opening your mind fully

to a spiritual teacher-guide whom God will make available to you. This is predominately for your personal spiritual growth, but if you truly desire to be of graceful service, without ego aggrandizement, then you may be asked to TR to a group as well.

- 4— TR via computer. From verbalizing the teachers, it was a short stretch to learn this skill at the keyboard. A collective of personalities representing the Teaching Mission was willing and able to answer my questions and concerns via the keyboard. You can do this too. In fact, most transmitters find it easier than oral transmitting. So this kind of transmission, whether it is called automatic writing, TR, channeling or whatever, may be the best first step for you.
- 5 Celestial Artisans. In my case, this led further to communications with a colony of spiritual artisans. They have served here to some degree through the ages, instilling higher spiritual purpose to our creativity, and seeking to enhance the creative spark with which we are all imbued. Again, the spiritual energy circuits are being increasingly opened, in increments on our planet, Urantia, so that the works of angels, guides, teachers and artisans can be more easily accessed by human searchers.

You may tap into these spiritual energy circuits to enhance your own creative work, and this can include everything from teaching to plumbing. Bakim, the colony's chief administrator, urges us to live our very lives as an artistic expression, moment by moment, to be artists in all we say and do, especially in representing higher spiritual truth. If you desire creative inspiration that promotes true spiritual values, ask the celestial artisans for help while in the meditative "stillness," the quiet time of worship and prayer that every human should make a part of their life each day. From these times will come the spiritual energies that can move your life.

- 6 <u>Creativity.</u> Learning to access spiritual sources in creative work was the next link in my break with cynicism. For cynicism, like other spirit poisons, is not destroyed by fighting it, but rather by manifesting and expressing love, mercy, compassion, forgiveness, and service to all around you. Do this by creating some kind of art. Stay busy. In the presence of the eternal values, cynicism shrinks. Then in the presence of inspired creative effort that promotes higher values, it literally vanishes.
- 7 <u>Living in love</u>. By learning and accepting God's evolutionary plan for worlds of time and space as a

technique of creation, one begins to philosophically accept the way things are, however imperfect, for it is our task to bring them, and ourselves, to perfection. This is God's plan. This is our adventure, our learning and growing experience. Things are as they should be in our classroom/laboratory of material experience. Why be cynical about it?

To make this first, very human reach toward perfection, we will be best served by striving to live our lives in unconditional love — accepting the benevolent and loving Fatherhood role of God and, therefore, our brotherhood and sisterhood with all of the personalities he has created here. Such a small planet in such an out-of-the-way sector of the universe. Let's work harder to bring all people here together.

We can learn to live in love through a daily time of stillness and spiritual upreach, with worship, prayer, forgiveness, and loving service our watchwords. Through the stillness, our personal visit with God, the Father, each day, we will be given the strength, the energy, to do so, as well as incremental increases in the truth, beauty and goodness that we are able to assimilate, experience and express in our lives. When we are imbued with this spirit, we will be encouraged and empowered to radiate loving service each day.

The critical link to living in love and making spiritual growth possible is this regular time with God. A daily stillness program, practicing the four important elements of your spiritual life — worship, prayer, forgiveness and love — can be the synthesizing influence which will finally allow you to wipe out those persistent vestiges of cynicism.

Ironically, this simple exercise of devoting 10 minutes a day to your relationship with God may be the most difficult thing of all to accomplish. Many fail just because they can't still their mind. But nothing of real value is had without striving, and in every session of attempted spiritual upreach to God, we are blessed and rewarded whether we are mentally cognizant of it or not. This is true. We have made the effort; God judges us largely by the intent within our hearts, not by our weaknesses of the flesh.

Your author is not a perfected master of meditation. We all continue to work on our relationship with God, and will do so throughout this mortal experience and beyond. Here, we do so at our own levels, for each of us is a unique being in our own special place.

Through daily stillness practice, we can live more balanced lives of mind-body-spirit. This, in turn, helps

guarantee that egoistic fears and hidden agendas don't creep onto the open canvas that we seek to make available to our spiritual teachers and artisans who long to visit with us in these quickening, energy-expanding times, be our friends and guides, and tell us truths that help us grow spiritually.

If and when you seek direct spiritual guidance daily, even to transmitting to others, do not expect or even desire perfection in any of these steps; expect of yourself honest effort according to your abilities. This is enough for God, and for yourself.

Feelings of being inferior, of your shortcomings, are not of value in this process. You are gloriously imperfect. God purposefully created you this way so that you can grow. This doesn't mean you can't make contact with God through the Teaching Mission and get your own personal spiritual guide.

Get your busy mind settled and at peace in a quiet time with God. Be fully open and non-judgmental/analytical about what you're hearing. Just hear it, take it down, and study it. Pretty soon, you may have a real budding friendship with a spiritual guide.

My seven-step plan was not a quick fix, of course, but has become a long vocation, with new challenges for growth continuing in waves. A cynicism built over years of coffee shop grumblings is not wiped out in a day. But every day that you live in love and give of yourself in creative loving service is a day in which the absence of cynicism is refreshing indeed.

As best you can, fill your days with truth, beauty and goodness. Create art in your stature, your voice, your bearing, your skills, your kindness to others, the goodness you can shine forth from your very being. There will be no room for the base urges of the animal ego. Humankind has used the ego effectively for survival and human progress; now as we reach to a higher level of spirituality in our lives, the ego just gets in the way.

You will learn to live without your angry denunciations of what is wrong that essentially poison yourself, and then move beyond to ask and respond to the question: What will we do about it? What can I myself do about it? Do I not actually have the power to radiate loving energy around me every day? Can I just start to change the world by changing myself, and trying to turn those around me to love through my own goodness?

We come to the realization that the world will be changed one person at a time — and that's the best way

to do it. In part, because it gets every one of us involved.

We all have greater powers than we think to radiate love and change the very environment around us, physical and spiritual. Can we really make a contribution toward changing the bad things about the world? Much more than you now realize. God only asks us to service truth, beauty and goodness within our own arena. That is enough. We don't have to take on the world's problems. But we can expand our aura, to live in greater peace ourselves, and to share true perspectives with an increasingly larger audience. The angels will bring them before us; opportunities will be here, there and everywhere.

But wait — this book is supposed to be for cynics. We'd first better heal ourselves from the idea that the world is hopelessly screwed up and people are no damned good. If you're a true cynic, this first chapter won't fix it. And we all have to grow ourselves before we can have any logical inclination to try to teach others to live in love.

Spiritual growth means achieving more love in our lives, bringing with it a greater feeling of peace inside. Aligning our will with God's provides this vital link. Putting our lives and our best efforts in his hands. "The act is yours, the consequences, God's," says the Urantia Book. The act of accepting God's plan for you and striving to represent eternal values will put you in the everlasting arms of your ultimate Creator.

The stillness each day cannot be overemphasized. It is the threshold to future growth, your personal relationship with God in action. It is a conscious step of faith and, in your prayers therein, of loving service as well. If you respect God as your Father, you've got to visit him often, because he's right inside you. If you respect God, you will also nurture and do good to your brothers and sisters of the human family.

That final realization of God's piloting presence inside will give you the peace of mind you need, having already learned from The Urantia Book the truth of your personality's survival, if you choose to go on.

But before we hear what the celestial teachers have to say about all of this, let's clear up a couple of concepts — spirituality and apocalypse.

Is our world headed toward an end or a beginning, or both? And how can spirituality help if it hasn't already?

FINDING SPIRITUALITY, NOT DOGMA

Once disillusioned by dogma, many in the modern age have disdained spirituality. Though these two things are hardly the same, they're often interwoven in patchwork ways.

Churches have been bastions of spirituality, even as they have sometimes indulged in great evils — consciously and unconsciously. They are no more impervious to error and corruption than the other institutions which are shown to be failing us so dramatically in the 1990s. We must re-form them all and bring into them a spiritual essence.

Churches are mankind's ideas and interpretations of what religion should be, some of them well-meaning, others historically corrupted by egos, ignorance and power struggles.

But the churches and the partial errors they teach should be approached with a balanced view, not the kind of cynicism I once heaped upon them. I used to get worked up about both fundamentalist Bible belters and guilt-giving, sex-suppressed Catholic clergy before I learned to love everyone, regardless of their condition. The healthy and balanced view must see the good and the bad together in all things human, and like everything we encounter there are elements of both within our myriad of churches. We see this good-bad dichotomy even when we look in the mirror.

True religion, as opposed to organized churches, is your personal relationship with God, our Universal Father. If we accept that we are a child of God and all human-kind our brothers and sisters regardless of how they understand things, we can begin to work together to forge the kind of planetary cooperation that will be needed to reach a higher plane of life, a higher state of spiritual consciousness, for all people.

But we are not asked to change the world, but to change ourselves. That is all that is asked by God.

Affiliation with a church can be good for socializing and instruction, but each person should be strongly encouraged to develop their personal relationship with God. Priests and preachers have too often gotten between mankind and God, filling a vacuum with service, appealing to the spiritually lazy, but also exerting fear-based control based on ancient superstitions that never were true in the first place, often put in place only to aggrandize or reward the priesthood.

There is much primitive evolutionary garbage that humankind incessantly drags forward to hamper new revelation. Misunderstandings of Paul and others even polluted the teachings of Jesus. Judaism was hard to forsake entirely for many, as have been longstanding myths of other faiths that unfortunately survived time and were deified falsely for their ancient age. With Jesus, as interpreted by Paul and others, we have focused greatly on the miracle of the resurrection to the exclusion of much of Jesus' message, which centers around the Fatherhood of God and brotherhood of mankind — all mankind — Jews, Samaritans, Romans, Greeks, Englishmen, Russians, Muslims, and Hare Krishnas. And, of course, wo-man is as much a part of man or mankind as are males. It is so far above the concerns of mortal sex creatures.

Our modern-day Christianity is much according to the views of the apostle Paul, how he understood Jesus' message, and it focuses on the miraculous events of Jesus' life without full regard to his teaching that the Kingdom of God is within each one of us.

Supporting my early disillusionment with churches were history books, where I discovered that more people have been tortured, enslaved, and murdered in the name of religion than anything else except perhaps the acquisition of real estate, and actually those reasons were usually as intertwined as a bed of snakes.

I'm sure there are others who have let history's realities besmirch religion so thoroughly in their minds that they no longer have much interest in organized spirituality. Others have come to accommodate the truths they know from the Urantia Book while also enjoying the camaraderie and blessings of various churches. In truth, the Urantia Book and the Teaching Mission respect all efforts to know God and be like Him.

But the most valuable religion is inside each of us. No matter the historical realities of life on our planet, the true religion is with you and your God, in-close and personal, together, interacting, sharing life's experiences each day. This is real spirituality. One-on-one with God. And you're as worthy to talk to God and get spiritual guidance as the next person. You just have to recognize it and act upon it when it comes. It is most often cloaked in an opportunity for you to grow and learn.

What about religion's dark history? Well, it's just history, and cluttered with mankind's mistakes and follies. Better to live in the present-day, take it from here. In fact, better to learn to live in the moment, and

fill the moment with non-judgmental, unconditional love through the spirit of God that indwells us all. And live it artistically as well.

We don't have to necessarily like everyone and want to spend time with them, but God tells us to love them. If we do, we will, in turn, be blessed. We must try. That's all that God asks.

I now have a dear friend who is a retired Catholic priest, a dedicated Urantia Book student. Actually he works harder since retirement, ministering in prisons and wherever he can, energized to a life of service for God. He knows of my struggles with dogma and loves me gently, helps me grow. And he has a perfect line for those who know of the injustices the Catholics have wrought, the error they still perpetuate. "Well," he says, "the church is still evolving." If we are wise, we will know that we are too, all of us, and not be so hasty to criticize and make judgments.

The sins of mankind's religions through history has seeded much deserved mistrust, and so we have a secular society in the U.S. today that strives to keep dogma out of public policy. But secularism serves also to retard the divine goal of living in spiritual love in everything we do. When we put God back into our society, in a way that respects all concepts of God, then we will begin to put God back in our lives, in our parenting, in our ethical administration of corporations and government agencies, in providing jobs and selfrespect for all, in learning to rehabilitate those who fall rather than punish, alienate, and poison them so that they, in time, return with a vengeance to punish us – sometimes again and again. Prisons can be opportunities for spiritual rehabilitation, not schools for hatred and alienation.

Today, our planet teeters on the brink of a spiritual awakening, brought on by a powerful combination of evolutionary pressures, a pivotal turning of the millennium, a time when key issues will be faced and resolved before it's too late. These issues are being brought dramatically before us, day by day, in the media, in those we see around us who are twisted, trivialized, lonely and in pain, longing for a peace of mind that seems beyond reach.

In this time, we must turn inward for spiritual guidance if we are to withstand this age's challenges, then radiate God's energy that we find and fill ourselves with, to others around us. We must learn to become love radiators.

Fortunately, love is in there inside us, just shoved aside

by our sardonic cynicism, perhaps, that is designed to portray us as clever and cool, nobody's fool. We fool ourselves, not surrendering to the great truth. Inside each of us is a glowing spirit of light. This inner presence of Godliness can be nurtured and it will give us strength in a time of trials and tribulations and reckonings that are upon us, what some Christians refer to as an apocalypse.

WHAT APOCALYPSE?

Finding spirituality during what apocalypse? Some doomsdayers think the world is hell-bent for destruction, a final battle between good and evil. Traumatic times of upheaval. Quakes and other disasters as payback for our environmental excesses. And God may actually allow us to destroy ourselves in our evil and greed — or do it for us.

Many New Agers entwine this rhetoric with our environmental pollution, saying that natural disasters will ensue from our excesses. Some believe that celestial beings will help rescue at least the righteous among us, if we're really tuned in. Some put their services on the commercial market.

Some of us would argue any kind of end of the world is near. Annihilation would be pointless, even to God, especially to God. The idea of an apocalyptic end to an evil world conflicts with the very nature of God once you understand him as a Father who created you and loves you, and certainly loves his larger creation here on Urantia with an even more expansive love.

Enhanced spiritual energies are giving many hope of this submerged reality of an all-loving God today. The truth of these anticipated earth changes, within us and around us, may well be a lot less dramatic than our imaginations have made them. But enhanced energies are definitely at work here, the pace of change and expansion has quickened, compressing time. Many are attuning to genuine spiritual energies through their longing upreach.

Yet those who aren't spiritually attuned, living with little hope or faith, grow increasingly frustrated, not knowing where to turn for the love and peace they need. From their lack of spiritual-centeredness, they are and will continue to turn to frustrated destructiveness in their despair.

In these quickening, emotional times, in which the powers of electronic communication bring the suffering of the world into our living rooms, there is deep contemplation about true values. The spiritual-minded

will feel and respond to this as enhanced love energy, with an attendant desire for purifications, to heal themselves and one another, put away the old ways of greed and gain. But the restlessness of the unspiritual, who don't know how to channel the growing energy, and who resist the growing insistence of their spiritual urges, can actually turn to angry attack.

If we can help turn some of these brothers and sisters loveward, Godward, in the critical years ahead, no matter their comprehension of these things, we can help our world get through these times of apocalyptic change — in the best way we can, through loving service.

There is a growing hunger. With all of our contemplations and frustrations has come an awakening general and personal yearning for truer, deeper, more personal spirituality, whatever that may be construed to be. This is happening throughout the entire planet, wherever people live. In fact, the heightening energies actually are far greater than just global. We must begin to be cognizant of universes, even universes of universes, for they are there. Billions of planets, trillions of beings. And plenty of service opportunities without even leaving the planet.

If you would be a spiritual helper and teacher in these times, you will have plenty of opportunities. The restlessness is becoming rampant; the quest for spiritual clarity is growing more intense.

And many of us are finding this clarity through something still unthinkable to the scripture-bound -- direct celestial contact. In these times of planetary spiritual change, there are many volunteer personalities in the spirit world who are anxious to visit and serve here in these exciting times of epochal change.

The more perceptive among us are even seeing churches rumbling from within. They are slow to show the public their change, of course, but insiders in various churches talk of a restlessness to find this higher and deeper level of personal spiritual reality. The new energies being pumped in are working.

We see it too in the so-called new age melange of disciplines, dogmas and enlightenments. These various paths, which often stress methodology, are a booming business, only awaiting a great unifying realization that God is the Father of all humankind and we all are ONE as his children. Generally speaking this is the New Age's missing link.

In time, humankind will realize we're all talking much about the same thing with different terminlogies, and arguing too much over conduits, methodogies and mortal errors. Often, new agers express different versions of the same truths. The overriding truth above the all of everything of humankind's philosophy and religion is simple:

Love is the ultimate power. God is love. Serve Love.

From this is created truth, beauty, goodness, harmony, euphoria, whatever we need in our long, ascending universe career. Why else would God create you and allow you to live here in free will, except in love?

One of these days, we'll all discover that God's love is the answer to all questions. With the one simple realization and acceptance of this, current barrier questions of the scientist, the philosopher, the mathematician can be answered readily. Accept God and things will become clear.

Many are feeling an enhanced aura of spirituality from various fields of exploration, and many of them are bearing fruit. We should continue to seek the truth in all things, and make our own judgements. This is life, our learning and growing experiences.

Angels, our constant seraphic helpers, are very active all around us, and we are so much more aware of it than ever before. From the current wave of popular, inspiring and instructive Angel books will come a new wave of works from the same authors and others who will explore deeper and more meaningful spiritual truths. Angels are celestial messengers; the message itself is what we need. And we need to find the source of the message of truth, based on our own path to understanding. We are.

The spiritual teachers and guides coming through to us in the Teaching Mission are yet another part of the planetary awakening, the "Correcting Time" in their terminology. And they have many associates. The communications and broadcasting activities within a local universe of planets are truly amazing beyond our comprehension.

It's a busy, busy universe of personalities out there, and many different personalities are tapping into our energies with their own to give us their own particular kind of focused guidance in these changing and accelerating times. We are finding that their messages, though unique by personality and pereception, are in essence the same — God, love, oneness, faith, the

individual quest for truth, beauty, goodness, greater sharings thereof., service as the greatest calling. They will come to pass.

But meanwhile back on present-day Urantia, we know about disillusionment because we disappoint ourselves. We will find humans who will turn real, embellished and imagined spiritual powers to their own ends for money and standing. This will inevitably happen. We still have animal-like egos, necessary for us to progress this far. We are still very self-serving life forms, and this gives rise to both admirable characteristics and unenlightened ones.

There is good and bad, truth and error in all of us. There is even good and bad in the characteristics which shape us all. Some who make genuine spiritual contact have and will use it to bring disciples under their supposedly more enlightened aura, for power or profit. This is the kind of human ego trap that we must avoid. This is not celestially inspired; it is altogether from the human ego which has often been conditioned to fear and respond in fear, and seek to overcome it with aggrandized self-importance.

We must also guard against disdaining all true spiritual growth paths when we find that one has been befouled by a self-seeking or disillusioned human. This has happened through the ages, even following genuine spiritual contact, and it will continue as long as prideful and defensive egos push people into confused imaginings. To deal with the ego, read "A Course in Miracles" and the large outpouring of secondary works.

But having said there are rotten apples out there in humankind, there are also some excellent spiritual growth paths to follow out there. Don't let shysters and the misguided make you sour toward the idea of spiritual growth. Our objective with this book is to get you beyond that — in regard to all fields of humanly tainted endeavor, from lawyers to repairmen to fortune tellers to preachers and accountants.

Grow by letting God lead you to the right paths for you. Talk about these paths with God each day, then listen patiently for the answers to your concerns. They will be forthcoming. And if you want a constant, loving companion, ask for a personal spiritual guideteacher who will talk with you each day.

You can even get a name from your teacher if you wish, and personalize this experience as much as you choose. The choice is yours. This can be more important to your spiritual growth than any kind of socializing and

sharing activity you could get involved in, although they are quite valuable too. The key, however, is the personal relationship with God each day through the stillness. From there, you can get a personal celestial teacher in time; they are here in great numbers and eager to make contact and serve.

Beyond all and everything, you don't need to pay someone to make celestial contact for you. This is a gift that is yours for the striving, and when you finish this volume you will have the foundation of knowledge and the understanding of concepts that will allow you to do so.

It will be as simple as pouring your concerns out to God, the Father, in your personal time and letting your personal assigned teachers speak or write through you to get the stream-of-their-your-consciousness experience that will give you some very illuminating, sometimes startling, spiritual truths.

As far as the material world out there, a sampling of many kinds of activities is often good for you in your human life — but remember that you and God can have a personal relationship whatever your life path, and that's all you need for guidance. You have an inner light.

In these times, many are reaching to grasp an enhanced level of spirituality, more enlightened views leading to a truly altruistic society. Building a deeper personal relationship with God and all the fruits that this will bring is the key. This person-by-person growth and person-to-person service is what our planet's "Correcting Time" is all about.

To the perceptive, who can see just a little with spiritual eyes, there are signs everywhere that the world is changing, moving into an elevated state of consciousness. Sure, we see a lot of the "bad" in the media, but the bad must be exposed and brought to light before it can be dealt with. And things are being dealt with — dramatically. The issues of parenting, child abuse, family breakdown, the folly of war, lack of personal responsibility, political frivolities, corruption, legal system frustrations, ad nauseam are everywhere in the news, on our minds.

Much of the news disgusts, repels us, but our exposure to it by our infantile media is necessary. It must be brought forcefully to our agenda in order to drive correction, to inspire us to awaken to true spiritual values. The media, in time, will also be awakened as to what it should be doing to inform and promote under-

standings. This is happening already, with the great interest in matters of spirituality and healing. There is also an influential and vastly growing alternative media movement, print and electronic, that is beginning to change the face of planetary communications. Exciting times are ahead, people.

In politics, we have seen the world change almost overnight with the collapse of communist rule in the Soviet Union, and peace talks breaking out where war did before. The fall of the Soviet defused a horrific scenario of thousands of nuclear missiles alert and ready to be launched to the utter destruction of our planet. This seems an apt place to have begun our planet's "Correcting Time" if you were a celestial help force. Defuse the danger of complete planetary destruction first of all.

Yes, apocalyptic changes were forthcoming. Change brings resistance. Russia broke out in ethnic wars. Peace in the Middle East brought fanatics out to assassinate. But the spiritual awakening will overcome all of these backlashes. We will increasingly see peace breaking out.

We see also a burgeoning disgust with the failure of institutions, the realization that we have to take more civil responsibility to safeguard our much overemphasized civil rights, that we must take back our institutions from the mindless regulatory (and secular) nightmare that they have become by raising ourselves up to take a greater share of personal responsibility for our schools, our courts, our government, our churches, our lives, and those of our children.

We are learning that we can't turn our children's education over to the schools, our government over to bureaucrats, our religion over to the churches. We will soon realize more, deeper things, as these spiritual energy circuits are opened incrementally to help us lift ourselves to a higher consciousness — if we will attune to them.

Are we tuning in yet? The cynic in me would say: too little. The search for endless entertainment and the rush toward self-gratifications of all kinds have turned too many into junkies these days, glued to the tube, searching out new drug highs, sinking into alcoholism, capturing strange new flesh in bed. This kind of behavior has spawned generations of judgmental fingerpointers who had rather form their own enclaves of exclusiveness than to reach out to all brothers and sisters who are lost in their lack of understanding the

path to truth, beauty and goodness.

So if the planet is a classic showcase of alienation, how can it be said that we're emerging into a spiritual awakening? Isn't the cynic right about people's irresponsibility and greed?

It's not a matter of rightness. It's a matter of moving beyond the recital of woes about human nature and what it has led to, and start doing something about it by reforming ourselves and our institutions on strong spiritual values.

It is necessary for a realization of mankind's horrible mistakes to be brought to the agenda, to within the minds and hearts of people in order that we be disgusted and motivated to deal with them. We made the mess and we must be the ones to clean it up. We have free and open access to an enhanced level of spiritual assistance to help us do it — to show us how.

With this cleansing will come more opportunities in our continuing stream of learning and growing experiences that make us spiritually stronger. While we're just on the first life experience of our long, personalized ascension trek to ultimate perfection, it all begins right here, and it's a critical and important time for us.

So exposing the problem is necessary before we can start solving it. That is a first order of business during a spiritual awakening, and that is what some Christians might call an apocalypse. Things look bad for awhile. Disintegration, say the celestial teachers, is always seen before new growth.

It is my firm belief that the redemption of our planet will be a co-creative, co-cleansing process, humans working with celestial guides under the auspices of God and his Creator Son, who was Jesus.

The so-called apocalypse will be the end of an old era, an old way of thinking, followed triumphantly by a new era that features higher manifestations of truth, beauty and goodness within, without, and for all of us.

Is it an end or a beginning for you? Will you help gladly to spiritualize our world and correct its many problems, or will you say it's hopeless and just fight for the status quo, your own self-interest here in this short, mortal life?

Is the glass half-full or half-empty? Do you have faith and trust in your God that He will not allow the complete annihilation of our planet as a sinful world?

Or is your God wrathful and judgmental, willing to let us destroy ourselves, concerned not so much with this material planet as with your higher purpose in an afterlife if you follow the teachings of the Bible? What is your view?

I would encourage you to envision God as love. This is absolute truth. And then think accordingly.

In this end and new beginning that will mark the change of the millennium, you will have the opportunity to think deeply about spirituality, and to actually participate in this time of epochal change, a time when spiritual energies are beginning to help elevate mankind's level of thinking, the individual and collective consciousness, in order to bring forth, in a sense cocreate, this major planetary change.

Sounds a lot like New Age mystique, doesn't it? Well, there is no discounting the significant role of the New Age spiritual seekers of many kinds, many of whom are genuinely able to tap into universal spiritual energies whether or not they are able to completely understand and express them free of their own error and imagination. This is not easy for any of us. They are at least bold enough to try to understand more, and to move the planet forward compared to many of fundamentalist, scripture-worshipping mindsets.

In fact, there is no more error in the New Age movements than there is in the various religions and pseudoreligions. So let's not throw out babies or bath water. Let's all work together on this tiny planet to grow beautiful and spiritual babies and work to purify the deep spiritual waters which can unite us all in unconditional love and service to one another. Don't judge another's path. Blaze your own personal trail to God realization, working with the constant guide God has provided you from within and the other newly arriving "unseen helpers" who are anxious to be your friends — every day.

Is it really possible to bring this kind of spiritual idealism to our planet? Maybe not in our lifetimes. We'll have to accept that. This time-and-space adventure of ours is so extensive that it will require many generations to carry it forward to a state of what is called in The Urantia Book, the Era of Light and Life. This truly has to be an exercise in multi-generational cooperation. Evolution. Creationism too.

Will any of the Heavenly Father's multitude of planets achieve this Light and Life stage? Yes. Will all of them? Yes. Have many of them achieved this state

already, and is our planet as primitive and backward as we often think it to be? Yes again.

We will talk later about our planet's rebellion, what the Bible refers to as the "war in heaven," the true nature of Lucifer's and Satan's rebellion against God. We will see how this struggle continues today, and will come to ultimate triumph for God in these apocalyptic times during which we will all learn and grow.

During this coming spiritual awakening, we can actively participate for the rest of our lifetimes and then cheer on the struggles of our children and grandchildren who carry on after us on this, our native planet, using the values we instill in them. This is why parenting is such an important, indeed noble, calling on our planet.

This "apocalypse" of change may last ten years, a hundred years or a thousand. Only God knows. It depends literally upon millions of free will decisions that haven't even been made. There is one thing for sure — more information and revelation is coming. God continues to reveal himself through the ages. Truth is ever-growing as a giant oak, as we have the roots of knowledge to sustain it.

Some still worship certain information just because it is ancient and has withstood the centuries. Why? There was certainly no less confusion and corruption in ancient times than there is today. The age of a text does nothing to verify it, certainly not to one who has delved into the histories of religions and the politics and fantasy that swirls through these documents.

Certainly better than searching ancient histories for spiritual truths is the practice of living your spirituality daily through worship, prayer, forgiveness, service, living in the moment and reading some of the inspiring works that are flooding your bookstores in recent years. Ancient truths won't get you through these changing times; open to the newer revelations of God that you, yourself, are now ready for.

There are many kinds of people living today, on many paths. Some have stopped moving, have no interest in spiritual matters. Yet many are getting re-motivated.

A multitude still satisfies itself reciting the problems, wallowing in cynicism, disgusted with dogma, searching out self-gratifications, without love of humankind, or much hope for the future. Some become entertainment junkies.

Another multitude clings to faith and good values with

an increasing restlessness that the old ways aren't working and that we have to have fundamental, spiritual-value based change everywhere, starting with the family, the government and their churches. They are the good people, the salt of our earth for whom the old concepts of religion are quite enough if people would only practice them. And they wonder how this could come to pass.

And there is also a rotten core of evil and corruption that poisons our world as we look upon the vast panorama of the various continents and the incredible, depressing array of their people's needs. Can we truly love the oppressors in this multi-generational epic of evil that inflicts suffering upon the innocent. It continues unabated on most of the planet. We can love the sinner, while hating the sin.

And finally there are the sufferers, those borne and living in ignorance and poverty, struggling to get through the days alive. Understanding little. But with the spirit of God inside them, working with them at their own level.

All of us on this tiny planet together. Facing an apocalypse of change, a convergence of energy forces that will wrought major alterations upon the world in the immediate years ahead. Your years and mine. These are exciting times in which to live. We will not reach Light and Life here ourselves, but we will start the world moving in that direction.

How shall we face this apocalypse? Can we become centered, balanced in mind, body and spirit, so that we may survive, resist cynicism, and even thrive in giving loving service during this time? Yes, we can.

The Impatience of Eve ... and the call to Spiritual Action

Often we hear the admonition that we should avoid falling victim to impatience, that Eve's actions in the first garden is illustrative of what happens when we are impatient. Her mistake cost the second epochal revelation its full fruition.

Paper-74 Section-8 Para-14 Page-838 Line-38 Para-6 The "golden age" is a myth, but Eden was a fact, and the Garden civilization was actually overthrown. Adam and Eve carried on in the Garden for one hundred and seventeen years when, through the impatience of Eve and the errors of judgment of Adam, they presumed to turn aside from the ordained way, speedily bringing disaster upon themselves and ruinous retardation upon the developmental progression of all Urantia.

How does this apply to we human beings? In my opinion very little. I will discuss this very little aspect.

Eve was revelator; we are evolutionary mortals. Eve was under revelation mandates when she accepted her assignment to this world as a biologic uplifter and revealer of truth. We all know the lengthy admonitions, warnings, and rules that Immanuel gave to Michael just before his seventh bestowal. He was given some very specific guidelines, never to have a child is one. Eve was given the order along with Adam, and it applied to their offspring, that they were not to breed the violet blood with other human strains until the gene pool could become large enough and be better able to uplift all without diluting the violet source to soon. She had clear cut orders. Do we humans have these same orders, at least orders that apply to evolutionary free will mortals? We obviously are not under revelation mandates. In reflecting, I come up with a few mandates:

Be you perfect as the Father in heaven is perfect. Love God with all your heart, mind, strength, and soul. Love your fellows as you love yourself. Contribute to the growth of the Supreme.

In Eve's case impatience was an element in the disruption of the second epochal revelation, but impatience wasn't the error, the action taken was the error. I wouldn't be surprised if every celestial on the planet at the time of Edenic Mission would have cheered heartily for the rapid adoption by the surrounding clans of the teachings and lifestyle of the Adamites. So yes, we can heed the admonition to not let impatience get the best of us, but Eve is in a catagory different than ours. She was here to reveal; we are here to grow. She had a decided advantage over us and was not to step too far ahead for our sake. That she didn't

heed. We are on a peer level together. We need to help each other apply our mandates (listed above). As peer level evolutionaries I don't think any one of us can step too far ahead of anyone else and thwart the mandates that apply to us. If that were the case then Jesus would be in the wrong for attaining the first circle and qualifying for fusion at the young age of 29.

Impatience ought not to be missconstrued to imply that we need only take a passive attitude to conditions on this world or in our own life, that all things work for the good, just wait on God. He has mandated us to become perfect, not to wait patiently for Him to perfect us. We must not side step our mandates; that is the only connection we have with Eve. Otherwise we should get on with our work just like she spent several hundred years getting on with her work before her default.

Good things to consider regarding impatience:

Paper-54 Section-4 Para-4 Page-616 Line-11 Para-3 Most of the liberties which Lucifer sought he already had; others he was to receive in the future. All these precious endowments were lost by giving way to impatience and yielding to a desire to possess what one craves now and to possess it in defiance of all obligation to respect the rights and liberties of all other beings composing the universe of universes. Ethical obligations are innate, divine, and universal.

Paper-130 Section-5 Para-3 Page-1436 Line-26 Para-5 One day when Ganid asked Jesus why he had not devoted himself to the work of a public teacher, he said: "My son, everything must await the coming of its time. You are born into the world, but no amount of anxiety and no manifestation of impatience will help you to grow up. You must, in all such matters, wait upon time. Time alone will ripen the green fruit upon the tree. Season follows season and sundown follows sunrise only with the passing of time. I am now on the way to Rome with you and your father, and that is sufficient for today. My tomorrow is wholly in the hands of my Father in heaven." And then he told Ganid the story of Moses and the forty years of watchful waiting and continued preparation.

Both these passages illustrate that impatience goes wrong when it attempts to supplant the natural course of time with artificial means for effecting change. It also shows that much of what we long for we already have. Jesus was proactive in his ministry simultaneous with his patient waiting upon time. (He would plant the tree THEN wait for it to grow.)

THE IMPATIENCE OF EVE ... and the call to Spiritual Action

This proactive orientation is what we can have rather than a passive (avoiding impatience) stance which only leads to stagnation. The ten talent parable speaks to this point. No matter what psychic circle we each are on, how educated we are, how much we long for change in this world we are to put to use our talents and are expected to make increase. Only then are we to be patient as we await the course of events that allow us to make further progress and change. Eve was proactive in volunteering for her assignment on Urantia. She made many efforts toward improving the planet, all of which were seemingly radical and strikingly different than what the surrounding tribe cultures were like. Her work toward this end wasn't impatience.

Wouldn't it seem absurd to say to Eve, "Hey Eve! Back off. Don't you know you'll never get anywhere using impatience to motivate you? Give us a break with all this advanced agriculture, social enlightenment, and biologic uplift adgenda of yours. Wait on God. He'll straighten it out." No! She was to make progressive moves and THEN patiently await the turning of time for more opportunities to uplift the world. Patience must follow action not replace it. IMHO

What about speeding up our growth? (emphasis is mine)

Paper-19 Section-5 Para-12 Page-221 Line-9 Para-2 And from all this, you mortals, just now taking your first step on the eternal journey, can well see that you must advance a long way before you will progress by "sight" and "material" assurance. You will long use faith and be dependent on revelation if you hope to progress *quickly and safely*.

Paper-131 Section-3 Para-5 Page-1447 Line-11 Para-2 "No religionist may hope to attain the enlightenment of immortal wisdom who persists in being *slothful, indolent, feeble, idle, shameless, and selfish*. But whoso is thoughtful, prudent, reflective, fervent, and earnest—even while he yet lives on earth—may attain the supreme enlightenment of the peace and liberty of divine wisdom.

I view these passages above as a balance between the proper use of patience - waiting for the fruition of time - with the improper use - burying your talent so as to not offend the master if by chance you lost your lot. The second is patience leading to inaction, the first is patience following after action. I'll repeat, Eve took action, then was impatient. Her mistake was when she did become impatient that she took the wrong action based on the revelation mandate.

Paper-48 Section-5 Para-8 Page-551 Line-14 Para-3 One of the purposes of the morontia career is to effect the permanent eradication from the mortal survivors of such animal vestigial traits as procrastination, equivocation, insincerity, problem avoidance, unfairness, and ease seeking. The mansonia life early teaches the young morontia pupils that postponement is in no sense avoidance. After the life in the flesh, time is no longer available as a technique of dodging situations or of circumventing disagreeable obligations.

Let's not let patience fall into that category of vestigial animal traits.

Paper-100 Section-1 Para-2 Page-1094 Line-18 Para-5 Some persons are too busy to grow and are therefore in grave danger of spiritual fixation. Provision must be made for growth of meanings at differing ages, in successive cultures, and in the passing stages of advancing civilization. The chief inhibitors of growth are prejudice and ignorance.

Let's not let patience twist our orientation such that our busy mundane lives take president over doing good work for the kingdom of heaven.

Paper-149 Section-2 Para-1 Page-1670 Line-11 Para-3 Jesus understood the minds of men. He knew what was in the heart of man, and had his teachings been left as he presented them, the only commentary being the inspired interpretation afforded by his earth life, all nations and all religions of the world would *speedily* have embraced the gospel of the kingdom. The well-meant efforts of Jesus' early followers to restate his teachings so as to make them the more acceptable to certain nations, races, and religions, only resulted in making such teachings the less acceptable to all other nations, races, and religions.

It's okay to foster growth, to enhance progress, to speed along evolution IF one can also pace oneself along with the velocity of cultural progress. Caligastia didn't pace himself; neither did Eve. Both were here on Urantia with the express purpose of effecting major changes in the condition of the world. They just didn't want to wait.

Are we humans, who's mandate is to be perfect, love God, love all others, and help grow the supreme, going to let patience be distorted to mean we continue to impeed all nations and all religions of the world from speedily embracing the gospel of the kingdom?

Paper-100 Section-1 Para-8 Page-1095 Line-17 Para-3 Religious habits of thinking and acting are contributory to the economy of spiritual growth. One can develop religious predispositions toward favorable reaction to spiritual stimuli, a sort of conditioned spiritual reflex. Habits which

The factors of religious growth may be intentional, but the growth itself is unvaryingly unconscious.

We are to be patient when it comes to grow itself. But are we not also encouraged to proactively "develop religious predispositions toward favorable reaction to spiritual stimuli"? Patience follows action. The desire to improve the world is not impatience. The efforts made by anyone of us is not impatience. The error of impatience comes from not letting the effects of one's actions run with the natural course of evolution. That was where Eve stepped in and ignored her mandates.

Yes, Eve ran aground through impatience, thwarting the revelatory plans for this world. But she, both before and after the default, never succumbed to complacency (distorted patience). To use Eve as example of why another brother or sister's action is a sign of impatience should only be used when and after a brother/sister has taken actions toward growth and can't face the reality of the passing of time for the effects to occur. Then we ought to counsel with patience. But to use Eve as an example for not stepping forward and effecting change on this world in the first place is to fall into the trap of fostering stagnation and retarding the growth of this world to Light and Life.
